

EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

- 1. Claims 1-3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 13-15, and 17-24 are allowed.
- 2. An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.
- 3. In claim 2, line 12, the word "plate" has been changed to --play--.

Allowable Subject Matter

4. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: upon close review of the claims, the prior art, and applicant's remarks it appears that the allowance of claims 1-3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 13-15, and 17-24 are appropriate.

The wireless game player and gaming machine of U.S. Patent No. 6,846,238 by

Wells is functionally equivalent to the claimed control apparatus and control method including a mobile communication terminal and a game play portion including the claimed limitations of: a game play portion being separate from the mobile communication terminal wherein a game is played exclusively on said game play portion and not on the mobile communication terminal and input personal information is provided by the mobile communication terminal. Although, Wells teaches enabling a game play according to personal information (Wells: col. 9, line 52 – col. 10, line 21; col. 11, lines 55-67; col. 25, line 40 – col. 26, line 6), Wells fails to teach making a call via said mobile communication terminal to an accounting center, information service center, or Internet service provider as recited in claims 1-3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 13-15, and 17-23 and making a

call to an Internet service provider to check if a user is on a list of subscribers as recited in claim

24. Therefore, Wells does not meet the requirements of the claimed invention.

Further, it would be contrary to the teaching in Wells to modify the control apparatus

and control method to: make a call via said mobile communication terminal to an accounting

center, information service center or Internet service provider and make a call to an Internet

service provider from a game play portion, since Wells discloses the game play portion performs

verification and authentication of a user of the wireless game player (Wells: col. 11, lines 55-67;

col. 20, lines 29-47).

5. Any comments considered necessary by applicant must be submitted no later than the
