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DETAILED ACTION

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

1. Claims 9 and 20-21 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, second paragraph, as being indefinite for failing to particularly point out and distinctly claim the subject matter which applicant regards as the invention.

Claim 9 is vague because it is not clear as to how the resonant cavity can have a cylindrical shape and a substantially planar surface. A cylinder normally has curved walls, especially a cylinder with a diameter as small as 10-100 microns, so it is not clear as to where a planar surface is found. The last part of the claim is also not clear with respect to how the additional array of optical cavities are related to the cylindrical optical cavity in the biosensor.

Claim 20 is vague. The last part of the claim recites a fluorescently labeled analyte in the application step. So, in addition to the analyte in the sample, a fluorescently labeled analyte is also applied to the surface of the resonant optical cavity?

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

2. The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.

3. Claims 5 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by Stone et al (US Patent 5,742,633).

Column 4, lines 1-31, of Stone et al teach a resonant optical cavity with a Q (quality) factor of 10^4 .

Allowable Subject Matter

- 4. Claims 6, 11, 17-19, and 22-28 are allowed.
- 5. Claims 10 and 12-16 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.
