DETAILED ACTION

Response to Arguments

Applicant's arguments, see Appeal Brief, filed 11/25/2008, with respect to the previous rejection have been fully considered and are persuasive. The rejection of the claims has been withdrawn.

Claims 20 - 85 are allowed.

Reasons for Allowance

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Applicant argued the combination of Swartzendruber in view of Runion was non-obvious because the rotation stop element was absent for preventing rotation between the inner and outer cylinder, the Examiner agrees. The combination of the stop element of Runion with Swartzendruber would not be obvious as the stop element of Runion is for the screw ring relative to the outer cylinder NOT the inner cylinder relative to the outer cylinder. The prior art of record fails to cure this deficiency.
