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EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

Authorization for this examiner's amendment was given in a telephone interview with Mr. Melanius D'Souza on 9/5/07.

The application has been amended as follows:

In claim 31, at line 3, after "N1+N2+N3", 'where "N1", "N2", and "N3", are integers' has been deleted and --where "N1" and "N2" are non-zero integers--.

In claim 31, at line 8, after "modules", 'equaling 0 or 1' are deleted and --switching between two numbers 0 and 1-- has been inserted.

In the title, 'Modular Regenerative Heat Exchanger System' has been deleted and --Method of Operating a Regenerative Heat Exchanger System-- has been inserted.

This application is in condition for allowance except for the presence of claims 1-30 directed to a non-elected group I without traverse. Accordingly, claims 1-30 have been cancelled.

Allowable Subject Matter

Claims 31-37 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: the prior art of record either taken singularly or in combination fails to disclose the step of idling the selected Application/Control Number: 10/501,610 Art Unit: 3744

regenerative heat exchanger module for "P3" seconds, where "P3" equals "N3*(P1+P2)/(N1+N2)" wherein "P2" is the time that the second gas passing through the selected regenerative heat exchanger module.
