DETAILED ACTION

Election/Restrictions

Restriction is required under 35 U.S.C. 121 and 372.

This application contains the following inventions or groups of inventions which are not so linked as to form a single general inventive concept under PCT Rule 13.1.

In accordance with 37 CFR 1.499, applicant is required, in reply to this action, to elect a single invention to which the claims must be restricted.

- a. Group I, claim(s) 1-21, 32-34, and 38, drawn to drawn to an implantable component of a cochlear implant system and method of adjusting the position of the implantable component.
- b. Group II, claim(s) 22-31, drawn to an external component of a cochlear implant system with a support and a signal transmitter antenna movable mounted to the support.
- c. Group III, claim(s) 35-37, drawn to an implantable component of a cochlear implant system that is substantially symmetric about a longitudinal and/or lateral plane.

The inventions listed as Groups I, II, and III do not relate to a single general inventive concept under PCT Rule 13.1 because, under PCT Rule 13.2, they lack the same or corresponding special technical features for the following reasons: Group I contains an implantable component of a cochlear implant system and method for adjusting the implant wherein following the implantation the housing can be moved without the removable electrode assembly. Group II contains an external component of a cochlear implant with a movable signal transmitter. Group III contains an implantable component of a cochlear implant system that is symmetric around one or more defined planes. Accordingly, none of these inventions share a common technical feature. A telephone call was made to Ajay Jagtiani on April 24, 2007 to request an oral election to the above restriction requirement, but did not result in an election being made.

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Applicant is reminded that upon the cancellation of claims to a non-elected invention, the inventorship must be amended in compliance with 37 CFR 1.48(b) if one or more of the currently named inventors is no longer an inventor of at least one claim remaining in the application.
