REMARKS

Summary of the Office Action

Claims 1-4 and 7 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) as being unpatentable by Miyaguchi et al. (JP 11-188033) (hereinafter "<u>Miyaguchi</u>") in view of Yamamoto et al. (JP06-196680) (hereinafter "<u>Yamamoto</u>").

Claims 5 and 6 are allowed.

Summary of the Response to the Office Action

Applicants have canceled claims 1-4 and 7 without prejudice or disclaimer. As a result, claims 5 and 6 remain currently pending for consideration.

Rejections under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a)

Claims 1-4 and 7 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) as being unpatentable by <u>Miyaguchi</u> in view of <u>Yamamoto</u>. Applicants have canceled claims 1-4 and 7, rendering the rejection moot. Accordingly, withdrawal of the rejection to claims 1-4 and 7 is respectfully requested. The Examiner is thanked for the indication that remaining claims 5 and 6 are allowed. Accordingly, prompt issuance of a Notice of Allowance is respectfully requested.
