Inventive Step

Claims 1-4, 7-10, 13-16 and 19

Document 1 describes that MIP-1 α enhances the chemotaxis of a dendritic cell precursor (page 373, Abstract, Figure 1).

Document 2 describes that RANTES enhances the chemotaxis of a dendritic cell precursor (Fig. 1).

Document 3 describes that if an amphipathic polymer such as a partially butyl-esterified styrene-maleic acid copolymer is used to modify a cell chemotactic factor such as IL-8 or MIP-1α, the activity of the said factor is sustained (claims 1-15, page 4, line 18).

Document 4 describes that BB10010 that is a functional derivative of MIP-1 α is a derivative suitable for preparations improved, for example, in the solubility posing a problem with MIP-1 α (page 4400, Abstract).

In this regard, the applicant (1) states in the written reply dated 14 September, 2004 that even if, for example, MIP-1 α that is also a chemotactic factor for neutrophils is administered, the number of neutrophils in peripheral blood does not increase, and (2) insists that even if cell chemotactic action occurs *in vitro*, the action does not always occur *in vivo*.

However, before the filing date of the present application, in the field of drugs, it is a technique well known to a person skilled in the art that a dendritic cell precursor collected from peripheral blood is used for, for example, immunotherapy, and it is also considered to be an issue well known to a person skilled in the art to efficiently collect the said precursor when the said therapy is practiced. So, a person skilled in the art could have easily conceived of enhancing the chemotaxis of a dendritic cell precursor and administering any of various factors having an action to induce the said precursor or any of their derivatives into blood for increasing the concentration of the said precursor in blood.

Furthermore, since the specification of the present application supports only MIP-1 α and BB-10010 as the factors that increase the level of a dendritic cell precursor in blood actually also *in vivo*, it is not considered that the effect of the subject matters of claims 1-4, 7-10, 13-16 and 19 containing a factor other than the said MIP-1 α and BB-10010 as an active ingredient is a special effect that could not have been predicted by a person skilled in the art.
