DETAILED ACTION

Claims 5, 6, and 27 are pending in the instant application. Claims 1-4, 7-26 and 28-33 have been canceled.

Response to Final Action

Applicant's response and amendment to the claims filed on 11/14/08 are acknowledged. The rejections and objections made in the previous office action are withdrawn in view of the amendment to the claims.

Examiner's Amendment

An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.

The application has been amended as follows:

In claim 5, last line, **insert** ---or an enantiomer or a mixture of enantiomers, or a pharmaceutically acceptable addition salt thereof--- after the word haloalkyl at the end of the claim.

In claim 6, line 1, **delete** "derivative" and **insert** ---compound--- after the word ureido.

Reasons for Allowance

The present invention is directed to benzenesulfonic acid compounds of formula (IIa). The closest prior art of record is U.S. PAT 3,332,981 (Shultis et al), which teaches a similar

compound, except all the compounds are stilbenesulfonic acid compounds. There is no motivation in the Shultis reference to make benzenesulfonic acid compounds without the corresponding stilbene moiety. In addition, the instantly claimed compounds cannot encompass a stilbene moiety at the R1 or R2 position. Support for the term "pharmaceutically acceptable carrier" can be found in the specification on page 31. Therefore, the compounds and compositions are allowable over the prior art.
