

NEW ABSTRACT A method of rehabilitation including providing a first actuator (1900), that includes a movement mechanism (1902, 1904) capable of applying a force that interacts with a motion of a patient's limb in a volume of at least 30 cm in diameter, in at least three degrees of freedom of motion of the actuator and capable of preventing substantial motion in any point in any direction in the volume; coupling the first actuator to a first point on a human body; providing a second actuator that includes a movement mechanism (1906, 1908) capable of applying a force that interacts with a motion of a patient's limb in a volume of at least 30 cm in diameter, in at least three degrees of freedom of motion of the actuator and capable of preventing substantial motion in any point in any direction in the volume; coupling the second actuator to a second point on the human body; and applying different forces to the points using the actuators.
