DETAILED ACTION

Election/Restrictions

1. Newly submitted claims 83 and 99 directed to an invention that is independent or distinct from the invention originally claimed for the following reasons: Claims 83 and 99 are directed to an article comprising a carrying case and an instrument. Claim 83 does not further limit the limitations of the correlation spectroscopic instrument. The article (a transport vehicle, for example) does not need the particulars of the carrying case or the instrument, and therefore claims 83 and 99 are restrictable. The same logic applies to claim 64 also.

Since applicant has received an action on the merits for the originally presented invention, this invention has been constructively elected by original presentation for prosecution on the merits. Accordingly, claims 64, 83 and 99 have to be withdrawn from consideration as being directed to a non-elected invention. See 37 CFR 1.142(b) and MPEP § 821.03.
