DETAILED ACTION

Priority

1. Applicant's claim for domestic priority under 35 U.S.C. 119(e) is acknowledged.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

2. The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless -

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.

3. Claims 1-3 and 11-13 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being clearly anticipated by

Westmoreland, Jr. et al., Journal of Organometallic Chemistry, Vol. 25, No. 2, pages 329-335

(1970). The Westmoreland reference discloses tetraalkylammonium tetraalkylaluminates salts.

See Table I at page 331 and Table II at 332. See also experimental section at page 334.

4. Claims 1, 3 and 17 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being clearly anticipated by Symmes, Jr. et al., Journal of Organic Chemistry, Vol. 43, No. 6, pages 1250-1253 (1978). The Symmes, Jr. et al. reference discloses phenyl(1,1,3-trimetylpropyl)phosphonous dichloridealuminum chloride complex. See complex 2 at page 1251. See also experimental section on page 1252.

5. Claims 1, 3 and 17 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being clearly anticipated by GB 1,031,839. The '839 GB patent discloses the compounds $[C_2H_5PCl_3]^+[AlCl_4]^-$ and $[C_2H_5PCl_3]^+[Al_2Cl_7]^-$. See examples 1 and 2.

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Claims 1, 3, 11 and 12 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by U.S.
Patent No. 4,857,238 A. The '238 patent discloses the compound [CH₃PCl₃]⁺[AlCl₄]⁻. See Example 6.

7. Claims 1, 2 and 11 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being clearly anticipated by U.S. Patent No. 3,418,216 A. The '216 patent discloses an ammonium-halide-alkylaluminum salt. See Tables I-III at columns 3 and 5.

Allowable Subject Matter

8. Claims 4-10 and 14-16 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.

9. Claims 18-30 are allowed over the prior art of record.
