DETAILED ACTION

Election/Restrictions

Applicant's election without traverse of Group III, inorganic zinc species in the reply filed on 11/07/05 is acknowledged.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 103

Claims 9-11,15-17 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Bartnik et al 5399353 in view of Modak et al 6037386

BARTNIK shows methods of treating skin,(background) inclusive of animals, including dairy cattle (col. 7, lines 20-col 8 lines 13, & claim 4) with chlorhexidine & zinc oxide. Powder forms are specified C ol. 5, lines 45-50, bottom, col. 6). chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) is exemplified(col. 19, exmples 91-93,95,96) Chlorhexidine acetate(CHA) is not exemplified.

MODAK (col. 5, Ilines 20-43,col. 6, lines 5-7, col. 8 bottom, examples, 4, col. 15, & col. 10) also treats skin with chlorhexidine, including CHA & CHG, shown as equivalent, with inorganic zinc, zinc oxide, in powder forms (col. 9, lines 60-63) @ 0.05-5% antimicrobial (col. 8, lines 50+) @ A 1:13-2:1 (col. 9, top) to, for example (col. 10, bottom) zinc oxide. Examples 4,5 show CHA with zinc oxide & corn starch carrier.

It would have been obvious to a person of ordinary skill in the art at the time the invention was made desiring to utilize pest control means, to use any of art recognized means, as of the BARTNIK powders modified as desired to increase stability, dispersibility, compatability of ingredients, processing ease, reduced toxicity to handlers, and to include any of the chlorhexidines as shown equivalent by modak

All the critical elements of the instant are disclosed. The amounts and proportions of each ingredient are result effective

parameters chosen to obtain the desired effects. It would be obvious to vary the form of each ingredient to optimize the effect desired, depending upon the particular species and application method of interest, reduction of toxicity, cost minimization, enhanced, and prolonged, or synergistic effects.

Applicant has not provided any objective evidence of criticality, nonobvious or unexpected results that the administration of the particular ingredients' or concentrations provides any greater or different level of prior art expectation as claimed, and the use of ingredient for the functionality for which they are known to be used is not basis for patentability.

The instant invention provides well known old art recognized compounds, with well known art recognized effects, applied by well known art recognized methods to achieve improved control as is well known in the art.
