#### **DETAILED ACTION**

1. This office action is in response to the supplemental response filed on March 02, 2009, which was filed in this application after appeal to the Board of Patent Appeals and Interferences, but prior to a decision on the appeal.

- 2. Examiner and Attorney reached an agreement during phone interviews (as described in the paragraph 4 below) held on February 26-27, 2009, the appeal has been withdrawn and prosecution in this application has been reopened. Applicant's submission filed on March 02, 2009 has been entered.
- 3. Claims 1, 14, 51, 61, 64, 74 and 78 are amended; and none of the claims are cancelled or newly added. Therefore, claims 1-10, 12-23, 25-26 and 51-79 are currently pending in this application.

#### Telephone Interview

4. During the phone conversations on February 26-27, 2009, Attorney Aquino and Examiner Patel discussed on the interpretation of the claim limitation "a plurality of address encoders, a respective one of ..." in claim 1 and similarly in other independent claims. To overcome the applied interpretation of the above limitation in pending claims, Examiner and Attorney agreed to amend the claim as presented on 03/02/2009. Attorney agreed to withdraw the case from appeal.

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# Allowable Subject Matter

5. Claims 1-10, 12-23, 25-26 and 51-79 are allowed; and they are renumbered as 1-4, 10-11, 5-8, 12, 9, 13-16, 22-23, 17-20, 24, 21 and 25-53, respectively.

6. The following is a statement of reasons for the indication of allowable subject matter:

The prior arts of record do not teach nor suggest, either alone or in combination, <u>all</u> the limitations of the amended claims of the current invention (renumbered claims 1, 13, 25, 35, 38, 48 and 52); particularly a system or processor having a plurality of encoders that each provide an encoded address, which corresponds to a specific one register and processor mode, to a respective one of the input ports, wherein each of the plurality of address encoders corresponds to only one of the input ports.

Renumbered claims 2-4, 10-11, 5-8, 12, 9, 14-16, 22-23, 17-20, 24, 21, 26-34, 36-37, 39-47, 39-51 and 53 further limit the allowable independent claims. These claims are therefore allowable for the same reason as set forth supra.

Any comments considered necessary by applicant must be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee and, to avoid processing delays, should preferably accompany the issue fee. Such submissions should be clearly labeled "Comments on Statement of Reasons for Allowance."
