#### **DETAILED ACTION**

Claims 1, 3-7, 10-13, 16, 19, 21-22, 24-30 and 32-38 have been examined.

Claims 2-4, 8-9, 14-15, 17-18, 20,23 and 31 have been canceled.

Claims 1, 7, 19, 24 and 28 - 30 have been amended.

Claims 34 - 38 have been added.

#### Claim Objections

1. Claims 21, 26 and 32 objected to under 37 CFR 1.75 because they are dependent on canceled claims. See MPEP § 608.01(n). Accordingly, the claims 21, 26 and 32 have not been further treated on the merits.

#### Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

- The following is a quotation of the second paragraph of 35 U.S.C. 112:
   The specification shall conclude with one or more claims particularly pointing out and distinctly claiming the subject matter which the applicant regards as his invention.
- 3. Claims 21, 22 and 25, 26 and 32-33 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, second paragraph, as being indefinite for failing to particularly point out and distinctly claim the subject matter which applicant regards as the invention. They are dependent on canceled claims.

### Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 101

4. 35 U.S.C. 101 reads as follows:

Whoever invents or discovers any new and useful process, machine, manufacture, or composition of matter, or any new and useful improvement thereof, may obtain a patent therefor, subject to the conditions and requirements of this title.

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5. Claims 1, 5-7, 10 – 12 and 27, 28 – 29 and 34 - 38 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 101 because the claimed invention is directed to non-statutory subject matter. Examiner request that the Applicant consider tangibly embodying the "control program" of claims 1 (a), 28 and 34.
