REMARKS

Claims 1-43 are now pending in this application. In the May 31, 2007 Office Action, claims 1-11, 16-28 and 30-43 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(e) as being anticipated by *Bainbridge et al*, U.S. Patent No. 7,185,079 (hereinafter "Bainbridge"). Claims 12-13 and 29 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over *Bainbridge*. Claims 14-15 were objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but indicated as allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.

By this amendment, claims 1-13 and 16-43 have been cancelled and new claims 44-45 have been added. Following entry of this amendment, claims 14-15 and 44-45 will be pending in the present application. For the reasons set forth below, the applicants respectfully request reconsideration and immediate allowance of this application.

Allowable Subject Matter

In the May 31, 2007 Office Action, claims 14-15 were objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but indicated as allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims. In this regard, the applicants have amended claim 14 to include all of the recitations of the claims from which it previously depended. In light of this amendment, the applicants respectfully submit that claims 14-15 are in condition for immediate allowance.

New Claims 44-45

In the foregoing amendment, the applicants have also added new claims 44-45. These claims are computer storage media claims corresponding to allowable claims 14-15. Support for these claims can be found on at least page 9 of the Specification. Accordingly, in view of the previous indication of allowability of claims 14-15, and the foregoing amendment, the applicants submit that new claims 44-45 are also in condition for immediate allowance.

Conclusion

In view of the foregoing amendment and remarks, the applicants respectfully submit that all of the pending claims in the present application are in condition for allowance.
