SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO ELECTION REQUIREMENT

Sir:

Further to the election filed on 21 April 2005, the applicants have the following comments:

Contrary to the statement that "Currently, no claim is generic" in the election requirement of 21 March 2005, claim 1 is generic to all of the species. All of the species include a an oscillator circuit comprised of a CR circuit for providing a feedback circuit to an active device (such as invertors 1 to 3, 71 to 75 or the comparator 81), wherein the CR circuit is comprised of a first resistor group (5, 5a, 5b, 81) and a capacitor (4, 82) and a second resistor group (6, 83, 85) comprised of one or more resistors, wherein the second resistor group (6, 83, 85) is for adjusting a charge/discharge trigger voltage and a charge/discharge time associated with the capacitor (4, 82) of the CR circuit and wherein the second resistor group (6, 83, 85) has a temperature

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coefficient that is larger than a temperature coefficient associated with the first resistor group (5, 5a, 5b, 81).
