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Upon updating the search new prior art was found and will be applied in the below new grounds of rejections.

## Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

The text of those sections of Title 35, U.S. Code not included in this action can be found in a prior Office action.

Claims 1-30 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being clearly anticipated by Bedingham et al. (2002/0047003).

Bedingham et al. teach in figures 1 and 2 a device(10) comprising a substrate(20), first layer(30) and second layer(40).

Substrate(20) is polymeric but could be made of other materials such as glass, silicone, quartz, ceramics as taught in paragraph [0103]. The substrate(20) includes a first major side(22) and a second major side(24). Between these sides are formed process chambers(50) and distribution channels(60). Paragraph[0104] teaches layer(30) is provided to one side of the substrate(20) and includes a metallic sublayer(34). Paragraph[0104] teaches layer(40) that will transmit selected wavelength.

The claimed "transmissive layer" has been read on the taught **second layer(40)**, the claimed "control layer" has been read on the taught **substrate(20)** and the claimed "cover sheet" has been read on the taught **first layer(40)**. The claimed "conduit" have been read on the taught **distribution channel(60)**.

## Response to Arguments

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Applicant's arguments filed 12/29/08 were persuasive and have obviated the rejections over Harms. However, upon updating the search new and pertinent art has been found and has been applied above.
