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The amendment received 11 May 2007 has been made of record. Claims 1-15, 17, 18, 20-71, 109-116, 171-184, 360-375 and 427-430 are pending.

Claims 1-14, 17, 20, 29-55, 64-71, 109-112, 114-116, 171-184 and 427-430 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(e) as being anticipated by Markel et al.

Claims 23-25, 56-63 and 360-375 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Markel et al in view of Baetzold et al.

Each of these rejections is maintained for reasons of record. Applicants' arguments in traversal of this rejection focus on the allegation that the single catalyst used by the reference produces polymers that are either all amorphous or all crystalline. This argument is not persuasive in view of the claimed semi-crystalline nature of the polymers of the reference. Applicants need demonstrate by factual evidence in affidavit form that the polymers of the reference do not meet the amorphous/crystalline limitations of the rejected claims.

Claims 15, 18, 21, 22, 26-28 and 113 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.
