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The request for continued examination received 31 October 2007 has been made of record. Claims 1-15, 17, 18, 20-71, 109-116, 171-184, 360-375 and 427-430 are pending.

The request for continued examination did not contain any amendments to the claims or arguments against the rejections of record. Therefore, the rejections contained in the final rejection mailed 26 July 2007 are repeated below.

Claims 1-14, 17, 20, 29-55, 64-71, 109-112, 114-116, 171-184, and 427-430 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(e) as being anticipated by Markel et al.

Claims 23-25, 56-63, and 360-375 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Markel et al in view of Baetzold et al.

Each of these rejections is maintained for reasons of record.

Claims 15, 18, 21, 22, 26-28 and 113 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.
