DETAILED ACTION

Continued Examination Under 37 CFR 1.114

A request for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, including the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e), was filed in this application after final rejection. Since this application is eligible for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, and the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e) has been timely paid, the finality of the previous Office action has been withdrawn pursuant to 37 CFR 1.114. Applicant's submission filed on 05/29/2008 has been entered.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.

Claims 25, 29-30 and 43-50 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by Yuan et al. (U.S. Patent No. 5,387,212).

Yuan et al. disclose a medical implant comprising a first bone anchor (ref. # 20) having a first proximal head and a first distal threaded shank; a second bone anchor having a second proximal head and a second distal threaded shank; and a brace assembly comprising: a shell (ref. #11) coupled to the first proximal head; a brace (ref. #30) having a longitudinal axis and a slot (ref. #32) longitudinally displaced along the

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brace; a pair of bearings (ref. #45) displaced on opposite sides of the brace and positioned between the brace and the shell, each of the pair of bearings riding within the slot longitudinally displaced along the brace, wherein the bearings allow for slidingly adjusting (via groove ref. #32) and pivoting (via threaded parts ref. #21 and ref. #23, also pivoting may occur before ref. #401 and ref. #416 is clamped) the brace relative to the first proximal head along at least a portion of a longitudinal length of the brace. The medical implant further comprises a receptacle (ref. #11) ; and means for polyaxially attaching the receptacle to the second proximal head of the second bone anchor (ref. #21 and ref. #23); and wherein the receptacle comprises means for engaging with the brace. The medical implant further comprising means for locking the brace and the anchors in a fixed relationship with each other. The means for locking the brace and the anchors in a fixed relationship comprises one or more set screws (see ref. #'s 45, 416, 417, 411, 412). The one or more set screws clamps against one or more of the first and second heads to prevent movement of the brace with respect to one or more of the first and second bone anchors. The brace includes a second end portion that is at least partially ball shaped (see end of brace ref. #30). The second end portion snaps into the receptacle. The means for engaging the brace includes an inner surface of the receptacle that is keyed to match the second end portion. The brace is curved. The first and second bone anchors are pedicle screws. The brace assembly further comprises means for transmitting torque between the brace and the first distal threaded shank.

Allowable Subject Matter

Claims 53-56 are allowed.

Claims 51-52 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.

Response to Arguments

Applicant's arguments with respect to the claims have been considered but are moot in view of the new ground(s) of rejection.
