

REMARKS

Applicants thank the Patent Office for the careful attention accorded this Application and respectfully request reconsideration in view of the Amendment above and remarks set forth below.

In response to the Office Action mailed August 14, 2008, Applicants have amended Claims 63-65, 72, 74, 77, 78, 85 and 87 in order to avoid any basis for rejection under 35 U.S.C. 112, and have cancelled Claims 71, 73, 76, 86 and 89 without prejudice or disclaimer, reserving the right to file continuation applications on these claims. Applicants have also amended the Title to Invention.

Applicants will submit shortly a Terminal Disclaimer to avoid any double-patenting rejection in view of Applicant's copending U.S. Application Nos. 10/812,341 and 10/602,990.






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
