DETAILED ACTION

1. Applicant's Amendment filed 06/11/2004 has been reviewed and placed of record in the file.

Allowable Subject Matter

2. Claims 1-10, 12-17, 19-24, and 26-42 (to be renumbered 1-39) are allowable over the prior art of record.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The prior art of record fails to teach or render obvious a method of forming a memory cell having all exclusive limitations as recited in claims 1, 2, 4, 10, 12, 19, 26, 30-31, 33-40, and 42, characterized in that the conductive bit line is recessed below the uppermost surface of the base substrate by at least a first distance defined by the combined distances of a junction depth plus a depletion width of the transistor, or that forming a liner for a trench in a base substrate by thermally growing a first layer of oxide and depositing a second layer of oxide over the first layer of oxide; or forming a cap within a trench over a conductive bitline, the bitline at least within the trench and etched below an uppermost surface of a base substrate, the cap comprising a layer of nitride and a layer of insulating material over the nitride layer.
