DETAILED ACTION

1. This action is in response to the Amendment filed on 05/19/2009. After thorough search, application history, double patenting issues and in light of the prior art made of the record, claims 1, 3 and 6 are allowed.

Information Disclosure Statement

- 2. The information disclosure statements (IDS) submitted on 05/19/2009 and 06/10/2009 are in compliance with the provisions of 37 CFR 1.97. Accordingly, the information disclosure statements are being considered by the examiner.
- 3. The information disclosure statements filed on 03/11/2004, 04/23/2004, 06/14/2005, and 02/04/2009 fails to comply with the provisions of 37 CFR 1.98(b)(5) because they fail to list the dates of publication of multiple non-patent literature references, particularly those references listed as IDS filed on 03/11/2004 [NPL lines, aa-aj, am, ao], IDS filed on 04/23/2004 [NPL lines, aa-ad, af-am, aq, aaa], IDS field on 06/14/2005 [NPL, line 1], IDS filed on 02/04/2009 [pg. 4, line 4, pg. 5, lines 11-12]. However, these references have been considered. Even were the publication dates of these references such that they could serve as prior art under 35 U.S.C 102 § (a) or (b), none of them, either alone or in combination with any other reference, provide teaching sufficient to form a basis for a rejection under 35 U.S.C § 102 or 103.

Reason for Allowance

4. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The closest prior art of record US 2004/0225711, Burnett et al. teach or suggest a system is disclosed for administering a computing grid including a grid manager computer and

grid computers utilizing a communications network for permitting communication there between. A method aspect includes receiving a parameter communicated from each of a plurality of the grid computers, with the parameter characterizing an aspect of the grid computer communicating the parameter. At least two grid computers are logically grouped together in a virtual subgrid of grid computers on the computing grid. Each of the computers of the subgrid may have a similar level of the parameter, or may have a similar relationship to a reference level of the parameter. A job is assigned to one or more computers of the subgrid when the job requires a level of the parameter that that is characteristic of the grid computers of the subgrid. Matsunami et al. US Patent No. 6,775,830 teach or suggest a computer system including a plurality of computers, a management console operated by the operator to install a program in the computers and a storage subsystem coupled to the computers and the management console is disclosed. The storage subsystem includes a first storage unit shared by the computers and a plurality of second storage units exclusively used by the computers respectively. The first storage unit has stored therein a file related to the program installed in the computers and an installer program for executing the work of installing a program. The second storage units have each stored therein an install agent executed by each computer and a control file accessed by the install agent. The management console includes an install manager for starting the execution of the install agent on each computer. The install manager starts the process according to the install agent on each computer by switching on the power supply of each computer. The install agent, once the process thereof is started, starts the installer program in accordance with the

contents of the control file. The installer program reads a related file from the first storage unit, and transfers it to the second storage unit exclusive to the corresponding computer thereby to install the program and Bishop et al. US Patent No. 5,754,552 teach or suggest debugging a computer program by simulating execution forward and backward in a main history log and alternative history logs.

- 5. In Applicant's invention modify a relationship between manager services in response to the command; receive from a grid management computer, a first application containing code for enabling the resource on the respective associated computer system to be used by a separate computer system, the first application having a first application class type; determine whether an application having the first application class type is currently installed on the respective associated computer system; the modification of the behavior of the resource of the respective associated computer system occurring upon determining that a second application having the first application class type is not yet installed on the respective associated computer system; and wherein determining that the resource is no longer needed is performed by the manager services waiting a prespecified amount of time and then deinstalling the application if there is no additional request for the resource received within the prespecified amount of time are not taught or suggest by Burnett, Matsunami and Bishop.
- 6. Some other arts that are presented of the record but are not same as invention are Naik et al. US 2006/0294238 which present policy-based hierarchical management

of shared resources in a grid environment and Kroening et al. US 2004/0215590, system for assigning and monitoring grid jobs on a computing grid.
