Applicants respectfully request a refund in the amount of \$220.00, which we believe was wrongly charged to Deposit Account No. 19-2814 on July 17, 2009 (see attached Patent Application Fee Determination Record and Sales Receipt for Accounting Date: 07/17/2009).

On August 12, 2008, Applicants filed an Amendment and Reply to Office Action comprised of sixteen (16) total claims, five (5) of which were independent. At this time, Applicants paid for two (2) additional independent claims. The Patent Application Fee Determination Record generated with this filing indicated that the Amendment consisted of sixteen (16) total claims, four (4) of which were independent. Applicants respectfully submit that this accounting was in error. (See attached Listing of Claims from the Reply and Amendment filed August 12, 2008, the Patent Application Fee Determination Record and the Electronic Patent Application Fee Transmittal indicating that two (2) additional independent claims were paid for at this time.)

On July 13, 2009 Applicants filed a Reply and Amendment to the Final Office Action dated May 12, 2009, along with a Request for Continued Examination (RCE). At this time, Applicants paid the \$810.00 fee for the filing of the RCE. The claims filed in the Amendment and Reply to Final Office Action consisted of fifteen (15) total claims, five (5) of which were independent. Since Applicants had previously paid for the additional independent claims with the August 12, 2008 filing, Applicants did not pay any additional claim fees at this time, as none were required. However, the Patent Application Fee Determination Record Sheet generated with the July 13, 2009 filing indicated the amount of claims previously filed were twenty (20) total claims, four (4) of which were independent. Applicants respectfully submit that this accounting of claims was incorrect, as explained in detail above. (See attached Patent Application Fee Determination Record.) Therefore, the charge of one (1) additional independent claim on July 17, 2009, for a total of \$220.00, was in error.

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Therefore, Applicants respectfully request a refund in the amount of \$220.00, which was wrongly charged to Deposit Account No. 19-2814.

Listing of Claims:

1. - 19. (Canceled)

20. (New) A method comprising:

receiving a transaction request from an RF transaction device, wherein said transaction request comprises a transactions counted value; and

denying said transaction request in response to said transactions counted value exceeding a maximum transactions value.

- 21. (New) The method of claim 20, wherein said transaction request further comprises at least one of an RF transaction device authentication tag, an account issuer routing number, or an encrypted transaction device identifier.
- 22. (New) The method of claim 20, further comprising transmitting an interrogation signal to said RF transaction device.
- 23. (New) The method of claim 20, further comprising:

 transmitting said transaction request to a transaction processing entity; and
 receiving a denial message from said transaction processing entity in response to said
 transactions counted value exceeding said maximum transactions value.
- 24. (New) The method of claim 20, further comprising disabling said RF transaction device in response to said transactions counted value exceeding said maximum transactions value.
- 25. (New) The method of claim 20, further comprising:presetting said transactions counted value to an initial count value;

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setting an increment value for said transactions counted value; and setting said maximum transactions value.

26. (New) A radio frequency identification (RFID) reader comprising:

a transponder for receiving a transaction request from an RF transaction device, wherein said transaction request comprises a transactions counted value; and

a network device for denying said transaction request in response to said transactions counted value exceeding a maximum transactions value.

27. (New) The RFID reader of claim 26, further comprising:

means for receiving at least one of a transaction device authentication tag or an encrypted transaction device identifier from said RF transaction device; and

means for decrypting said encrypted transaction device identifier to authenticate said RF transaction device.

28. (New) A transaction processing entity comprising:

means for receiving a transaction request from an RF transaction reader, wherein said transaction request is initiated by an RF transaction device, and wherein said transaction request comprises a transactions counted value; and

means for denying said transaction request in response to said transactions counted value exceeding a maximum transactions value.

29. (New) The transaction processing entity of claim 28, wherein said transaction request further comprises at least one of an RFID reader authentication tag, an RF transaction device authentication tag, or an encrypted transaction device identifier.

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- 30. (New) The transaction processing entity of claim 28, further comprising means for validating said RF transaction device in accordance with said RF transaction device authentication tag.
- 31. (New) The transaction processing entity of claim 28, further comprising means for evaluating validity of said RFID reader in accordance with said RFID reader authentication tag.

32. (New) A method comprising:

transmitting a transaction request to an RFID reader, wherein said transaction request comprises a transactions counted value, and wherein said transaction request is denied in response to said transactions counted value exceeding a maximum transactions value; and

incrementing, at said RF transaction device, said transaction counted value.

- 33. (New) The method of claim 32, further comprising incrementing said transactions counted value by a predetermined value.
- 34. (New) The method of claim 32, further comprising incrementing said transactions counted value in response to at least one of receiving an interrogation signal, transmitting data, or completing an RF transaction.
- 35. (New) A Radio Frequency (RF) transaction device comprising:

means for transmitting a transaction request to an RF Identification (RFID) reader, said transaction request comprising a transactions counted value, wherein said transaction request is denied in response to said transactions counted value exceeding a maximum transactions value; and

means for incrementing, at said RF transaction device, said transactions counted value.
