Referring to Figures 2 and 3, the insertion tools 20 and 30, in one embodiment of the invention, have an elongated shaft including a handle 21 and 31 at one end and at an opposing end a receptacle 22 and 32 which conforms to and supports the junction of the prosthesis cylinder and connection with the tubing. A notch of similar diameter with the tubing is utilized as a receptacle. At its widest cross-section, the receptacle has a dimension of approximately one centimeter. The receptacle has a smooth peripheral edge and finish which guards against damage to penile tissue and the prosthesis device in the surgical placement of the prosthesis. The insertion tools 20 and 30 have the further advantage of not having sharp angles, which get entangled with the sutures during corporotomy closure.
