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### DETAILED ACTION

1. The Applicant's amendment, filed 26 November 2007, has been received and entered into the record, respectfully and carefully considered.

2. As a result of the amendment, claims 1 and 11 are amended. Claims 2 and 12 are canceled. Therefore, claims 1, 3-11 and 13-21 are pending in this application.

# Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

3. As a result of the amendments to the claims, the examiner withdraws the pending claim rejection under 35 U.S.C. § 112.

### Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 101

4. As a result of the amendments and explanations, the examiner withdraws the pending claim rejection under 35 U.S.C. § 101.

5. The examiner further notes that as per claims 1 and 3-10, the Applicant confirmed that the processor in claims 1 and 3-10 is a **hardware** processor (See interview summary). Also, for example on page 27, line 21 of the original disclosure which indicates that the response to interrupts, at least at first level, is performed by hardware. Additionally, "wherein when said processor is executing a program..." is being recited in claim 1. To a person with ordinary skill in the art a hardware processor is capable of executing program. Thus, the processor in the claims is a hardware processor and claims 1 and 3-10 are statutory.
