Election/Restriction

According to the Office, the current application is subjected to an election/restriction requirement under 35 U.S.C. §121 as containing three patentably distinct inventions:

- I. Claims 1-11 are drawn to a method for developing and installing an application comprising an application framework, a navigation framework, and application lifecycle management components, classified in class 717 and subclass 174.
- II. Claims 12-15 are drawn to a computer-readable medium encoded with computer-executable components for defining a scope of an application via various window objects and classes, classified in class 715, subclass 804.
- III. Claims 16-23 are drawn to a computer-readable medium encoded with computer-readable components for identifying, exposing, and defining various navigation-related properties, methods and events, classified in class 715, subclass 804.

Applicant respectfully elects Group I, which encompasses claims 1-11, without traverse.
