INTERVIEW SUMMARY

Applicant sincerely thanks Examiner Wood for conducting a telephonic interview with Applicant's representative, David W. Foster, on March 26, 2008.

During the interview, Applicant's representative respectfully traversed the Office's rejections under 35 U.S.C. §101, 35 U.S.C. §112 second paragraph, and 35 U.S.C. §103(a). For instance, Applicant's representative respectfully submitted that the cited references ("Bowman-Amuah" and "Sprigg") at least fail to teach or suggest "a component that defines a mechanism that allows the application to access common window properties of a hosting environment in a like manner regardless of whether the hosting environment is a browser or a standalone window environment" as recited in independent claim 1. Applicant's representative understood Examiner Wood to tentatively agree that the claims as amended would be allowable over the cited references. Applicant's representative also understood Examiner Wood to agree that amending claims 1-11 to recite computer-readable storage media would overcome the 101 and 112 second paragraph rejections.
