REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

Claims 10 – 13 are allowable.

With regards to claim 10, the examiner cannot find applicable prior art and / or suggestion disclosing conversions based on the first and second conversion conditions are weighted depending on distances from right and left ends of the first image <u>in</u> <u>combination with</u> the rest of the limitations of claim 10.

With regards to claims 12 and 13, see the rationale and rejection for claim 10.
