In the Office Action, various claims were rejected under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) as being unpatentable over U.S. '576 in view of U.S. Patent 6,585,781, Japan 11-226290, or U.S. Patent 3,347,066. Applicants respectively submit that, based on this rejection, the Examiner considered that U.S. '781, JP '290, and U.S. '066 disclose

the same claimed subject matter. U.S. '781 was previously cited by the Examiner on January 12, 2007. Therefore, Applicants respectfully submit that JP '290 and U.S. '066 are cumulative of U.S. '781.


