<u>REMARKS</u>

This Amendment was originally submitted as part of a Rule 312 Amendment.

Pursuant to the conversations with the Examiner, the Rule 312 Amendment was not entered because in the opinion of the Examiner's supervisor the Amendment changed the scope of the claims by deleting the "light shielding hood" from the claim 1, even though the deleted element was not in Applicant's opinion an essential feature of the allowed invention.

In any event, as part of this Request for Continued Examination, Applicant has amended the claims 1, 36, 37 and 38 in order to have the contents of the Rule 312 Amendment entered.
