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DETAILED ACTION

1. The Examiner's previous Office Action made final on (9/13/06) is vacated.

Allowable Subject Matter

- 2. Claims 1-5 and 7-9 (renumbered as claims 1-8) are allowed.
- 3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance.

Prior art of record fails to teach or fairly suggest a method and terminal for providing Global Positioning System (GPS) services using a mobile communication terminal which includes two lamps for incoming call notification, the comprising receiving GPS information from a GPS service provider and extracting left-turn and right-turn information from the GPS information; activating the two lamps as left and right lamps in concert with the extracted left-turn and right-turn information to provide navigation direction; checking whether a call signal for establishing a call connection is received and if a call signal is received, checking whether GPS information is currently displayed through the two lamps; if a first lamp of the two lamps is currently displaying GPS information including left-turn or right-turn information, allowing a second lamp of the two lamps to emit light that is a different color than the color of said first lamp; and if the two lamps are not displaying GPS information, operating the two lamps in a normal incoming call notification mode as recited in independent claims 1 and 5 and shown in figure 4.

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Prior art of record (Bocking et al U.S. 7,161,496) teach using only one lamp to indicate different modes of operation and is not concerned with providing incoming call notification simultaneously with left and right turn information by only using two lamps wherein one lamp used to indicate to the user to either turn right or left and if at the time of providing the user with this information a incoming call is received then using the other lamp to indicate incoming call by changing the lamp not being used for travel direction to be different in color.
