EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

1. An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.

Authorization for this examiner's amendment was given in a telephone interview with Dorothy Whelan on 1/12/07.

The application has been amended as follows:

IN THE SPECIFICATION:

At page 1, line 6, fill the blank with "10/761,742, now pending";

Page 1, line 7, fills the blank with "<u>U.S. Serial No. 10/762,030, now US</u> patent 6,852,563,"

Page 1, line 9 at the end of the first paragraph, insert "<u>US Serial No.</u> 10/761,862, now <u>US patent 7,125,949</u>".

IN THE CLAIMS:

Claim 17, line 6, after the phrase "etching a predetermined amount of the", replace the word "other" with "<u>remaining</u>".

2. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: the prior art fails to teach a process of making microelectrode including the step of etching a predetermined amount of the deposited metal film on the lower surface of the polymer micro-ridge as claimed.

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3. The closest prior art Sherman et al disclose a process of forming microelectrodes including the steps of forming a polymeric ridge (1310,1370), which is coated with metal layer (1312,1373) while keeping the coated metal layer on the lower surface (1365) for electrical contact (see col.37-38 and figure 56B) but fails to teach etching the coated metal layer on the lower surface leaving a metal film on the wall of the polymeric ridge.

Any comments considered necessary by applicant must be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee and, to avoid processing delays, should preferably accompany the issue fee. Such submissions should be clearly labeled "Comments on Statement of Reasons for Allowance."

4. Applicant is reminded that upon the cancellation of claims to a non-elected invention, the inventorship must be amended in compliance with 37 CFR 1.48(b) if one or more of the currently named inventors is no longer an inventor of at least one claim remaining in the application. Any amendment of inventorship must be accompanied by a request under 37 CFR 1.48(b) and by the fee required under 37 CFR 1.17(i).

Election/Restrictions

5. Claims 4 and 22, directed to dry etching, previously withdrawn from consideration as a result of a restriction requirement, claims 4 and 22 hereby rejoined and allowed with the allowable generic claims 1 and 17.

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Terminal Disclaimer

6. The terminal disclaimer filed on 12/6/06 disclaiming the terminal portion of any patent granted on this application which would extend beyond the expiration date of US patent 6,852,563 has been reviewed and is accepted. The terminal disclaimer has been recorded.
