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REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

1. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Scheper et al, U.S. Patent No. 6,013,613, discloses a low foaming automatic dishwashing composition comprising 5-90% by weight of a builder (see col. 2, lines 51-58), 0.1-15% by weight of a nonionic surfactant, such as block copolymers of polyoxyethylene-polyoxypropylene (see col. 5, line 44-col. 6, line 44), 0.1-70% by weight of a bleaching agent (see col. 10, lines 19-37), 0.001-6% by weight of an enzyme (see col. 11, line 62-col. 12, line 15), and adjunct ingredients. Specifically, note Examples 1-15. However, patentee differs from applicant in that Scheper et al does not teach or suggest in general a dishwashing composition that contains the specific nonionic surfactant required in the instant claims.

Accordingly, the claims viewed as a whole would not have been obvious to one of ordinary skill in the art at the time of the invention after viewing the prior art of record.

The examiner further notes that the provisional double patenting rejection of the instant claims over copending Application nos. 10/763,776 and 10/764,232 have been withdrawn in accordance with MPEP sections 804(I)(B) and 1490.
