2. Claims 1-16, 22, 26-27, 31-49, 69-70, 91-98 are currently pending in this application. Claims 22, 26-27, 35-40 and 43-49 are under consideration. Claims 1-16, 31-34, 69-70 and 91-98 are withdrawn as being drawn to non-elected inventions.

Allowable Subject Matter

6. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Claims 22, 26, 27, 35-40 and 43-49 are allowed. Claims are renumbered 1-16. The claims are drawn to an isolated attenuated gram-negative *Salmonella* cell comprising the SPI2 gene locus, wherein at least one effector *(sse)* gene selected from the group consisting of *sseC*, *sseD* and *sseE* of the SPI2 locus is inactivated, wherein

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said inactivation results in an attenuation/reduction of virulence compared to the wild type of said cell.

The closest proir art Shea *et al.* (*Proc Natl. Acad. Sci. USA* 93: 2593-7, 1996) and Hensel *et al.* (*Molecular Microbiology* 24(1): 155-67, 1997) fail to teach or disclose the particular effector (*sse*) gene selected from the group consisting of *sseC*, *sseD* and *sseE* of the SPI2 locus.
