### **REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE**

1. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The examiner has withdrawn the outstanding rejections of the claims in view of the amendment to claims 1, 9, and 22. These claims now specify that the gas return passage must extend in a direction from the second electrode to the first electrode. There is no obvious reason to incorporate this feature into the teaching of Beyer. In particular, although Beyer states that the holding tube can have an opening for the test gas (col. 4, Il. 27-30), there is no obvious reason why any such opening would have any directionality towards the first electrode. The reasons for allowing claim 24 can be found in the office action dated 11-14-2007.
