Remarks

Claims 1-6, 8, 10-17, and 19-25 are pending. Claims 21-25 are indicated as allowable and claims 2-7, 10-14, 16, 17, 19, and 20 are objected to. Claims 1-4, 8, 10-13, 15, 16, 19, and 20 have been amended. Claim 1 has been amended to include the limitation of claim 7, claim 8 has been amended to include the limitation of claim 9, and claim 15 has been amended to include the limitation of claim 18. Claims 2, 4, 10, 11, 12, 16, 19, and 20 have been rewritten in independent form. Claims 7, 9, and 18 have been canceled.

Claims 3, 12, and 19 have been amended to address the objections raised by the Examiner under 37 CFR 1.75(a). As these amendments merely correct typographical errors, Applicant submits that they create no prosecution history estoppel.

In response to the rejection under 35 U.S.C. § 112, second paragraph, the elements of claim 18 have been incorporated into claim 15 in such a way as to clarify the relationship of the surge protection circuitry with other components of the system. It is understood that Fig. 2 refers to "one embodiment of a power line infra-red (IR) transmitter 100" (para. [0008]) and paragraph [0027] states that "some of the components described herein may be combined." Accordingly, the application may include embodiments where the AC line interface and surge protection circuitry are combined.

It is respectfully submitted that all pending claims in the application are in condition for allowance.
