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DETAILED ACTION

Claims 1-4, 6-40 and 47-48 are currently pending. Claims 5 and 41-46 were cancelled.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

Claims 1-4, 6, 7, 14, 15 and 30 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by Levi et al, US 2003/0153556. As a result of the claim amendment filed 2/28/2006, which limits the definition of "heteroaryl" in claim 1 and all dependent claims, the rejection has been overcome and is therefore withdrawn.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

Claims 38-40 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by Levi et al, US 2003/0153556. As a result of the claim amendment filed 2/28/2006, which limits the definition of "heteroaryl" in claim 1, upon which claims 38-40 depend, the rejection has been overcome and is therefore withdrawn.

Examiner's Amendment
