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## **DETAILED ACTION**

- 1. Claims 3 and 4 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, first paragraph, because the specification, while being enabling for using either springs or pneumatic cylinders or hydraulic cylinders as the urging means (paragraph 0055), does not reasonably provide enablement for using springs, and pneumatic cylinders or hydraulic cylinders.. The specification does not enable any person skilled in the art to which it pertains, or with which it is most nearly connected, to make and use the invention commensurate in scope with these claims. Independent claim 1 recites using springs for the urging means, but claims 3 and 4 recite using alternative means, i.e., pneumatic cylinders and hydraulic cylinders, respectively. Since the instant specification does not support using both springs, and pneumatic cylinders or hydraulic cylinders, the scope of the claimed invention is not enabled. Correction is required.
- 2. Claims 1, 2, 5-6, and 11 are allowed.
- 3. Applicant's amendment necessitated the new ground(s) of rejection presented in this Office action. Accordingly, **THIS ACTION IS MADE FINAL**. See MPEP § 706.07(a). Applicant is reminded of the extension of time policy as set forth in 37 CFR 1.136(a).
