Sholder (U.S. 5,741,308) teaches that when using the measured natural conduction time

or intrinsic atrio-ventricular delay to set an AV (or PV) interval it is necessary to measure the

intrinsic atrio-ventricular delay over several cardiac cycles and then take an average of those

measurements so that the AV (or PV) interval is not set to an erroneous value that is base on a

single intrinsic atrio-ventricular delay measurement that is not representative of correct natural

conduction time (i.e. due to noise or a sensing malfunction).
