

### **REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE**

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Note that, Applicant's amendments, Applicant's arguments, and the Examiner's Amendment are sufficient to place the instant claims in condition for allowance.

Of the references of record, the most pertinent is Monteleone et al (US 5,258,070). Monteleone et al teach a mixture for the removal of nail lacquer comprising propylene carbonate, propylene glycol, and dimethyl isosorbide, and optionally, dimethylsulfoxide. See Abstract. However, Monteleone et al do not teach the use of canola oil and dipropylene glycol monomethyl ether as recited by the instant claims.

None of the references of record, alone or in combination, teach or suggest a nail polish remover composition containing propylene carbonate, canola oil, dipropylene glycol monomethyl ether, Vitamin E, and the other requisite components of the composition in the specific proportions as recited by the instant claims. Accordingly, since the prior art fails to teach or suggest such a composition as recited by the instant claims, the instant claims are deemed allowable.
