DETAILED ACTION

Response to Arguments

 Applicant's amendment to claims 27 and 40 to include all the limitations of previously objected to claim 35 places the application in condition for allowance.
 Additionally, in view of Applicant's amendment to the dependency of claims 36-38 there are no further objections to claims 36-38.

2. Applicant's amendments filed 4/21/2008 have been entered.

Allowable Subject Matter

3. **Claims 27-30, 32-34 and 36-40** (now renumbered 1-12 respectively) are allowed.

4. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

5. With respect to **claim 27** the prior art discloses a simultaneous reproduction camera which gives notice of when a still image corresponding to the reproduced video image is in memory and allows the user to switch reproduction to that of the associated still image. The prior art then discloses that during reproduction of the still image notice of the associated video is given and the user may select to return to the corresponding portion of the video.

6. However, the prior art does not teach or fairly suggest wherein when reproduction of the moving image data is restarted after reproduction of moving image data was interrupted by the still-image reproduction control unit to perform reproduction of still image data, the moving-image reproduction control unit starts reproduction of the

moving image data from a reproducing position corresponding to the timing indicated by the timing information regardless of whether a position at which the still-image reproduction control unit interrupts reproduction of the moving image data corresponds to any position corresponding to a time falling within the first predetermined period.

7. Claim 40 is allowable for similar reasons as that of claim 27.

8. **Claims 28-30, 32-34 and 36-39** are allowable for at least the reasons that they depend from **claim 27** which is allowable for the reasons discussed above.
