### Allowable Subject Matter

2. Claims 1-60, 65 are allowed.

3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance

#### Claim 1, 32, 33, 34, 45, 56, 57, and 58

The prior art of Nakajima and Ezekiel teach menu systems that allow for a system or event generated process to modify a menu within a graphical interface. The amended feature requires the system to modify an existing menu based on a supplied additional menu feed without the use of existing software and that the menu not be present within the menu prior to modification. The system of Nakajima allows developers to add or change context menus but the dll or software is existing on the machine and the menu is the same menu rather than a new modified context menu. Ezekiel does not remedy the deficiency of Nakajima when taking the claim as a whole.

Therefore, neither Nakajima nor Ezekiel teach the features of the amended claims as a whole and the claims are allowed over the prior art because the prior art does not demonstrate a method to modify a context menu by suppressing an existing menu and displaying a modified Art Unit: 2179

menu where the modified menu contains an additional menu item at a specific position and does

not use existing software and was not previously contained in the menu.

### Dependent Claims

Claims 2-31, 35-44, 46-55, 59-60 and 65 depend from claims 1, 32, 33, 34, 45, 56, 57, 58

thus are allowed for the same reasons indicated above.

### 101 issues

The "display, displaying on device and computer in claims 1, 32, 33, 56, 57 and 58 are interpreted as complying with the Bilski test and claims 34 and 45 have structural components to comply with MPEP 2106. Therefore, the claims are in compliance with 35 U.S.C 101.
