On page 7: the paragraph beginning on line 17 has been amended as follows:

As shown in the Figures 5A and 5B, preferably, the teeth of the set 48 are angularly offset from the teeth of set 50. so that the projection on one tooth 48 is not opposite a projection on a tooth 50. Moreover, the teeth of one set are offset from the teeth of the other set. This configuration forces the cord to take a serpentine path along channel 52.

- - , said pulley, teeth and flexible projections being molded together from the same material - - .

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Claim 6:

Line 16, "clutch" has been changed to - - pulley - - ;

Claim 12 has been canceled.

Claim 13, line 1, "12" has been changed to - - 10 - - .


Claims 17 and 18 have been canceled.
