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## **DETAILED ACTION**

## EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

1. The application has been amended as follows: on page 1 of the specification, underneath the title the following has been inserted -- This application is a continuation of U.S. application no. 09/436,186, filed November 08, 1999, now U.S. Patent No. 6,406,604. --

## Allowable Subject Matter

2. Claims 36-77 are allowed.

3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: independent claim 36 requires "a transport passage having a sample inlet end and an outlet end," the first separation passage to cross over the transport passage, the first affinity means to be in the first intersection, the second separation passage to cross over the transport passage to cross over the transport passage to cross over the transport passage.

In Foote (US 5,944,971) the first and second separation passages (16,18) intersect the transport passage (20) at first and second intersections, respectively. However, the separation passages do not cross over the transport passage. The

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separation passages end at the transport passage to form tee junctions. An electrode (30) runs along a continuous wall of the transport passage for creating an electrophoresis separation field down the separation passages. See Figure 1 and column 6, lines 51-60.

In Wiktorowicz (US 6,013,165) the first and second separation passages (170) intersect the transport passage (160) at first and second intersections, respectively. However, the separation passages do not cross over the transport passage. The separation passages end at the transport passage to form tee-type junctions. See Figures 3 and 4. Additionally, Wiktorowicz does not provide affinity means, such as antibodies, in the first and second intersections, but, in one related embodiment, immobilines for creating a pKa gradient along the transport passage. See column 15, lines 25-32.

In the embodiment of Figure 9 of Nelson there is only a first separation passage. The sample that passes through the first affinity means is immediately directed to a waste outlet. There is no suggestion to provide a second separation passage with a second affinity means as claimed. See column 14, lines 31-51 and Figure 9.

The claims in Guzman (US 6,406,604 B1) do not require at least two of the separation passages to cross over the transport passage. Also independent claims 1 and 14 of Guzman require the sample inlet to be provided by an introduction capillary, not the transport capillary.
