Examples of suitable substituents include alkyl, alkenyl, alkynyl, aryl, halo, trifluoromethoxy, trifluoromethyl, hydroxy, alkoxy, cycloalkoxy, heterocycloxy, alkanoyl, alkanoyloxy, amino, alkylamino, quaternary ammonium, aralkylamino, cycloalkylamino, heterocycloamino, dialkylamino, alkanoylamino, thio, alkylthio, cycloalkylthio, heterocyclothio, ureido, nitro, cyano, carboxy, carboxyalkyl ~~carboxylalkyl~~, carbamyl, alkoxycarbonyl, alkylthiono, arylthiono, alkylsulfonyl, sulfonamido ~~sulfonamide~~, aryloxy, and the like, in addition to those specified herein. The substituent may be further substituted, *e.g.*, by halo, hydroxy, alkyl, alkoxy; aryl, substituted aryl, substituted alkyl, substituted aralkyl, and the like.
