## A Foreword

THE foundation of the following article about the Hamilton family is an old record which was given me by my father, Gurdon Giles Sill, of Warren, Pennsylvania, about the year 1930.

The origin of the record is uncertain. It is signed "C. S. Hamilton, 1863." This was, no doubt, Charles S. Hamilton, born 1838, son of George B. Hamilton, of Battle Creek, Mich. In 1896 father's sister, Frances, visited the Hamilton relatives in Michigan, and it is supposed that the record was given her at that time.

Unfortunately, this old record contains no dates but its authenticity has been proved by comparison with fragments of Hamilton data found in Hopkins and Douglas Genealogies, and by inscriptions copied in several abandoned cemeteries in Cayuga County, N. Y., and in Weedsport Rural Cemetery in the summer of 1937 when my sisters and I visited that burial place.

From these sources, and from letters, some of them one hundred years old, I have been able to supply the dates which are a part of the records contained in the following pages.

For many of the later dates I am indebted to

the Enquirer and News of Battle Creek, Michigan. On June 30, 1933, I wrote the editor of that paper, enclosing a quotation from a letter written in 1841 to Eveline (Hamilton) Sill of Warren, Pa., by her brother, George B. Hamilton, one of the pioneers of Calhoun County, Mich. This action had a satisfactory result, for there appeared in the Enquirer and News on Sunday, August 20, 1933, a feature story about the Hamilton brothers who settled in Calhoun County in 1837. In addition to many facts of historical interest, the names of the descendants of these men were also published, thus bringing my records up to date, so far as their families are concerned.

We first hear of John Hamilton, our earliest known ancestor, in Hebron, Washington County, N. Y. He is said to have come here from Rhode Island, but we have found no trace of him in that state. There were Hamiltons just over the line in Windham County, Conn., and also Wilson, Dixon, Douglas, and Hopkins families, with whom the Hamiltons intermarried. (History of Windham County, Conn. Larned, 1880).

John Hamilton, in 1771, bought a tract of land in Washington County. The following year, John and Joseph Hamilton, Robert, Thomas, James, and John Wilson, and David Hopkins, settled on this tract, which consisted of 1000 acres, or one-half of the Campbell Patent. (History of Washington County).

From the Census of 1790 we learn that John



Hamilton, of Hebron, Washington County, had a family consisting of four males over 16, including himself; three males under 16, and five females. William Hamilton, and William Hamilton, 2nd, were also listed in that town.

There is a family tradition that John Hamilton, our ancestor, served in the Revolutionary War in Washington County, and was granted land in Cayuga County in recognition of these services. War records show that a Captain John Hamilton and, apparently, a John Hamilton, private, served in Washington County, but we have not been able to identify either with the John Hamilton, who, with his sons, John and William, settled on Lot 64, Brutus, in the year 1802, dying there in 1806. (History of Cayuga County. Storke, 1879). This lot was part of the Onondaga Military Tract, but the Land Records in the office of the County Clerk in Auburn, Cayuga County, N. Y., show that, in 1804, John Hamilton purchased this lot, 600 acres, from John Lansing, Jr.

This book is an account of the descendants of John and Jane (Wilson) Hamilton.

## Explanatory

In this book the system adopted for identifying the several generations is as follows:

The first generation, which includes the children of John and Jane (Wilson) Hamilton, is indicated by small capitals in parentheses: (A), (B), etc.

Succeeding generations are shown as follows:

Second, by Roman numerals: II, IV, etc.

Third, by Arabic numerals: 3, 5, etc.

Fourth, by lower-case letters: a, b, c, etc.

Fifth, by Arabic numerals in parentheses: (2), (4), etc.

Sixth, by lower-case letters in parentheses, (a), (b), etc.

Seventh, by Arabic numerals in brackets, [1].

It will be noted that there are variations in the spelling of certain names in this book, and that dates differ in some instances. In giving more than one spelling or date we are following closely our authority, whether it be the original record, grave-stone inscriptions, or family records.

(c) William Hamilton, b. 1771 or 1772, according to the old record "second child and first son of John," came to Cayuga County, N. Y., with his father in 1802. He had married, probably in Washington County, his cousin, Rachel Hamilton, daughter of Joseph.

He married, 2nd, Elizabeth Thomas, who was living at the time of his death, July 9, 1826, when she applied for letters of administration of his estate. He was then "in the 55th year of his age," according to the inscription on his tombstone in the old Weedsport cemetery, where he and his wife, Elizabeth, were buried.
