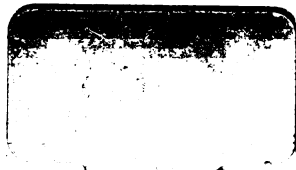

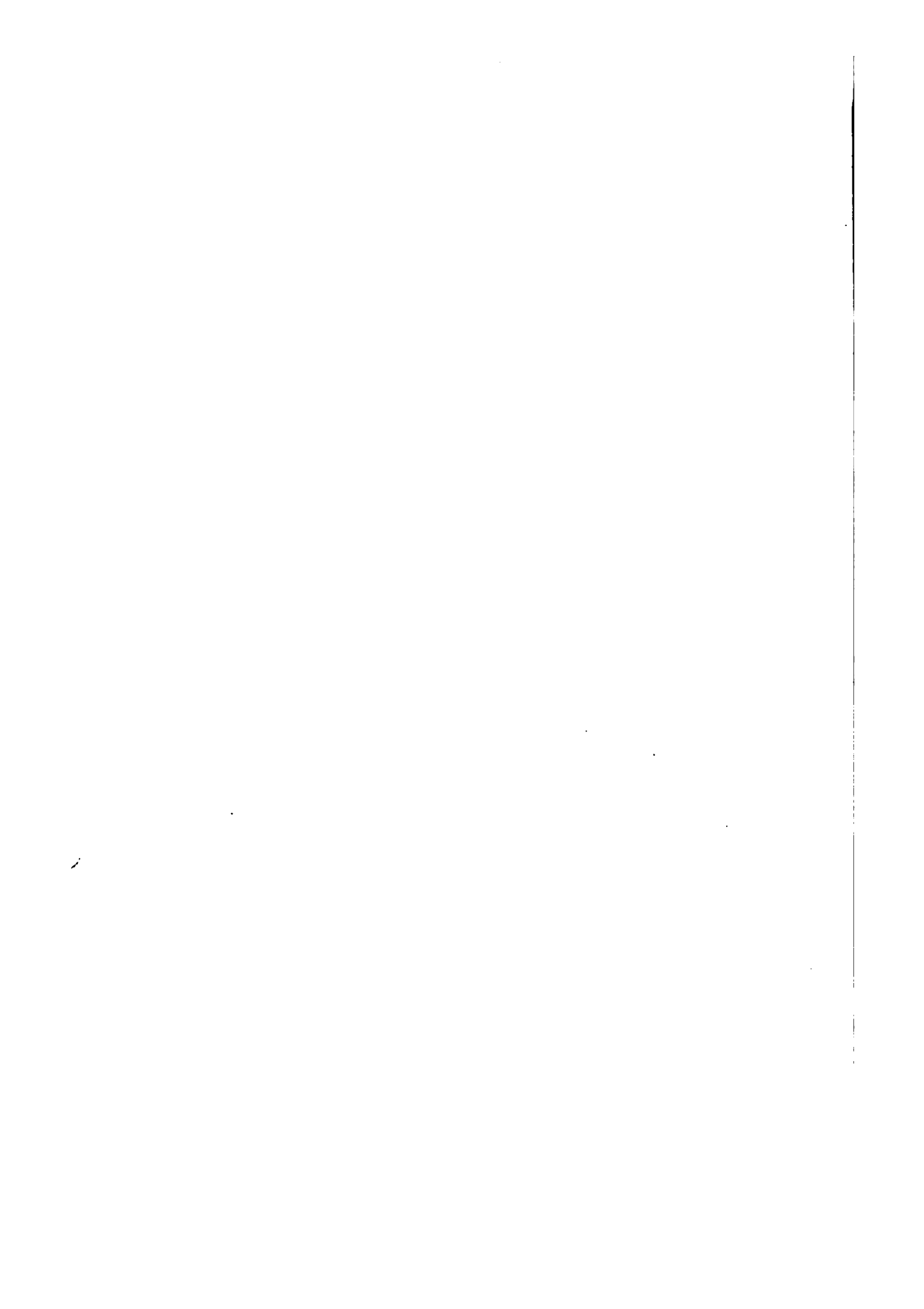

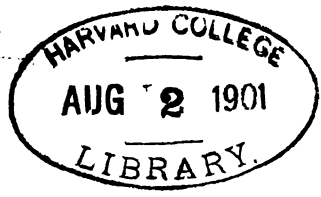

## PREFACE.

THE object of the Handbook of British, Continental and Canadian Universities is fully explained by its title, and may be found stated in the preface to the edition published in 1899. The Supplement is designed to indicate the changes that have taken place since the publication of the Handbook, and as far as possible to make the lists of the professors and lecturers at the different Universities and Colleges correct for the summer of 1901. In some universities announcements of courses for the ensuing semester are made very shortly in advance of the opening of the semester and in others the calendars and programs are published after great delay; on the whole, however, the lists given are, it is hoped, sufficiently accurate to be of service.

The Supplement is arranged alphabetically in the same manner as the Handbook, and a comparison of the information given in the Handbook with that given in the Supplement shows the changes that have been made. The appendix gives a list of the most important Fellowships and Scholarships for study abroad open to American students.

The editor wishes to express her thanks to all those who have so kindly supplied information and corrections, and will be grateful for corrections of any errors that may still have been overlooked. **GERMANY.**

The attitude of German Universities with regard to foreign students appears to be changing in the direction of making the requirements for admission more stringent. The investigation of the degrees and qualifications of a foreign student applying for admission to a German university has been until lately somewhat perfunctory, the result being that the universities have been crowded with badly prepared foreign students, many having an inadequate knowledge of the German language. In 1899, in the summer semester, 2,284 foreigners, mainly Americans and Russians, were matriculated in German universities, while about as many more were hearers. Graduates of American colleges and universities of good standing will have no difficulty in obtaining admission to any German university.

The qualifications of women students are similarly to be investigated more closely, and what is said above applies to them also. Their position is, on the whole, becoming legitimatised. Though admitted formally as 'hearers' or *hospitantinnen*, they are frequently permitted to take part in the work of the seminars and *Uebungen*, the decision depending on the individual professor and in some cases on the number of men students in the class.

In consequence of the fact that so many of the women students were inadequately prepared, the qualifications of women applicants for admission will now be carefully examined. Candidates should present their diplomas with their passports and testimonials. It is estimated that the stringent application of the regulations will reduce the number of women students by about nine-tenths.

An American woman recently obtained the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Teutonic Philology and women students were selected to debate the thesis.

The new University of Birmingham opened in October, 1900. It confers degrees in Arts, Science, Medicine and Surgery, and Dentistry. The Principal is Professor Joseph Oliver Lodge. At present the scientific faculty is the most completely organised. The general constitution of the university resembles that of the University of London.

LOCAL EXAMINATIONS AND LECTURES SYNDICATE,  
UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

The movement known as University Extension was initiated by the University of Cambridge in 1873 and was afterwards taken up by the University of Oxford and other universities in the United Kingdom.

In the Cambridge system one lecture is given and one class held in some special subject each week for twelve weeks, the students handing

in written work each week to the lecturer. At the end of the course an examination is held by an external examiner. A course consisting of 24 lectures and classes is called a sessional course, and students who pass the examination on a sessional course receive a sessional certificate. Students who take a course of study approved by the University covering at least three sessions and pass a preliminary examination in mathematics and languages are entitled to an affiliated certificate which admits to the University of Cambridge and gives students the privilege of proceeding to a degree after two years' instead of three years' residence.

The summer meetings of the Oxford and Cambridge University extension students are held conjointly at Oxford and Cambridge in alternate years. The meeting in 1901 will be at Oxford, and particulars will be found under "Oxford University Extension."

#### THE UNIVERSITY OF LONDON.

The University of London has been removed to the building formerly known as the Imperial Institute, South Kensington, London, S.W.

In 1898 the bill reorganising the University of London received the royal assent and since then commissioners have been engaged in framing the necessary statutes and regulations. Certain schools and colleges have been recognised as 'schools of the university' and students who have matriculated at the university and are pursuing in one of these schools a course of study approved by the Senate are called 'internal students.' The object of the change is to coördinate and control the higher education provided by the numerous colleges and medical schools in London and the provinces. Faculties of Engineering and Political and Social Science have been added so that degrees may now be obtained in these subjects.

## THE LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS AND POLITICAL SCIENCE.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.

The most important recent changes in the regulations of the University of Oxford are the changes in the requirements for the degrees of D.Litt., D.Sc., B.C.L., and D.C.L., which make it possible for graduates in arts of universities other than Oxford to obtain these degrees after a minimum residence of two years, *i. e.*, six terms. This is specially important for students of law, making it possible for a graduate of an American university to graduate in law at Oxford within a reasonable time. The degrees of B.C.L. and D.C.L. are highly esteemed.

#### THE ASSOCIATION FOR PROMOTING THE EDUCATION OF WOMEN IN OXFORD.

Since the last edition of the Handbook of British, Continental and Canadian Universities was published the work and scope of this Association have been somewhat modified by the growth and increasing importance of Somerville College and the Halls of Residence (Lady Margaret Hall, St. Hugh's Hall and St. Hilda's Hall). In Somerville College the work of the students is arranged and regulated by the principal or by the resident tutor in the subject in question; this is more or less true of the halls of residence also. In certain subjects for which it is advantageous for the women students, especially those from the smaller halls, to combine, the Association makes the arrangements for lectures.

American women students, qualified to belong to the Association of Collegiate Alumnae, are admitted without examination to the University examinations and to the College or halls of residence, but as the demand for rooms is very great it is advisable to apply for admission at least a year in advance. In consideration of the important part played by the tutorial system in the educational work of Oxford it is usually an advantage for American students to enter the college or one of the halls, if they wish to take the complete course or to do special research work. If they wish to study for two or three terms only they can rarely be admitted.

Students of the Association and of the College and Halls of Residence attend lectures by almost all the professors and lecturers in the University. In 1900-01 there were 203 women students in the College and Halls and 46 home students.

#### OXFORD UNIVERSITY EXTENSION.

The report of the University Extension Delegacy for the year ending September 30th, 1900, shows a great increase in the work of the delegacy. In 1899-1900, 1635 lectures were delivered as compared with 1231 in 1898-99. The aggregate attendance was 18,981. The Delegacy now has 64 lecturers.

In 1900-01 there were 137 women students registered in the university, 94 of whom were studying medicine. The requirements for admission are that citizens of the canton of Zürich who wish to enter the faculties of theology or medicine must hold the *Maturitätszeugniss* of the cantonal school, while for those who wish to enter the faculties of law and philosophy the certificate of the *Industrieschule* or of the normal high school is sufficient.

The fellowships and scholarships mentioned below are open to any properly qualified student ; fellowships and scholarships open to students of particular colleges and universities only are not enumerated here.

**ARCHÆOLOGICAL INSTITUTE OF AMERICA.**

Two Fellowships in Greek Archæology, of the value of \$600 each, open to men and women and tenable at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens, are awarded annually on the result of an examination. For further particulars see the Handbook, page 128, and the Supplement, page 47.

Two Fellowships in Roman Archæology, of the value of \$600 each, open to men and women and tenable at the American School of Classical Studies at Rome, are awarded annually on the result of an examination. A Fellowship in Christian Archæology, of the value of \$500, open to men and women and tenable at the American School of Classical Studies at Rome is awarded annually on the result of an examination. The Agnes Hoppin Memorial Scholarship, of the value of \$1,000, open to women only and tenable at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens or at Rome, is awarded annually on the result of an examination. For further particulars see the Handbook, page 128, and the Supplement, page 47.

**ASSOCIATION FOR MAINTAINING THE AMERICAN WOMEN'S  
TABLE AT THE ZOOLOGICAL STATION AT NAPLES.**

This association maintains a table at the Zoological Station at Naples and grants the use of this table to suitable applicants qualified to carry on original research in biology. An applicant who receives the use of the table for three months or longer is called a scholar of the association. The table is provided with all the necessary equipment for biological research work. Preference is given to women applicants, but if no suitable women apply men will be eligible in their stead. For further details see the Handbook, page 149, and the Supplement, page 57. #### ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGIATE ALUMNÆ.

A European Fellowship, of the value of \$500, open to women only, is awarded annually to a graduate of one of the colleges belonging to the association, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of one year's study in some foreign country. Preference is given to graduates of not more than five years' standing who show promise of distinction in the studies to which they devote themselves. The fellowship will not usually be given to any one intending to enter one of the learned professions, but rather to candidates who intend to teach or devote themselves to literary or scientific work. Applications for the fellowship, accompanied by diplomas, testimonials, satisfactory evidence of good health and, which is most important, examples of scientific or literary work in the form of articles or accounts of scientific investigations by the candidate should be addressed to the Chairman of the Committee, MRS. BESSIE BRADWELL HELMER, 1428 Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, before February 1st of the academic year preceding that for which the fellowship is desired.

#### BALTIMORE ASSOCIATION FOR THE PROMOTION OF THE UNIVERSITY EDUCATION OF WOMEN.

The Fellowship of this Association, of the value of \$500, is awarded annually to a woman student for the purpose of defraying the expenses of one year's study at an American or foreign university. Preference is given, in the award of this fellowship, to women from Maryland, or women who have identified themselves with educational interests in Maryland, who are graduates of not more than five year's standing and show promise of distinction in the studies to which they devote themselves. Applications, with testimony similar to that required for the fellowship of the Association of Collegiate Alumnæ, should be addressed to the Chairman of the Committee, DR. #### WOMAN'S EDUCATION ASSOCIATION OF BOSTON.

The requirements are the same as for the Association of Collegiate Alumnæ Fellowships, but candidates who intend to enter one of the learned professions are also eligible. **HOME SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS.**

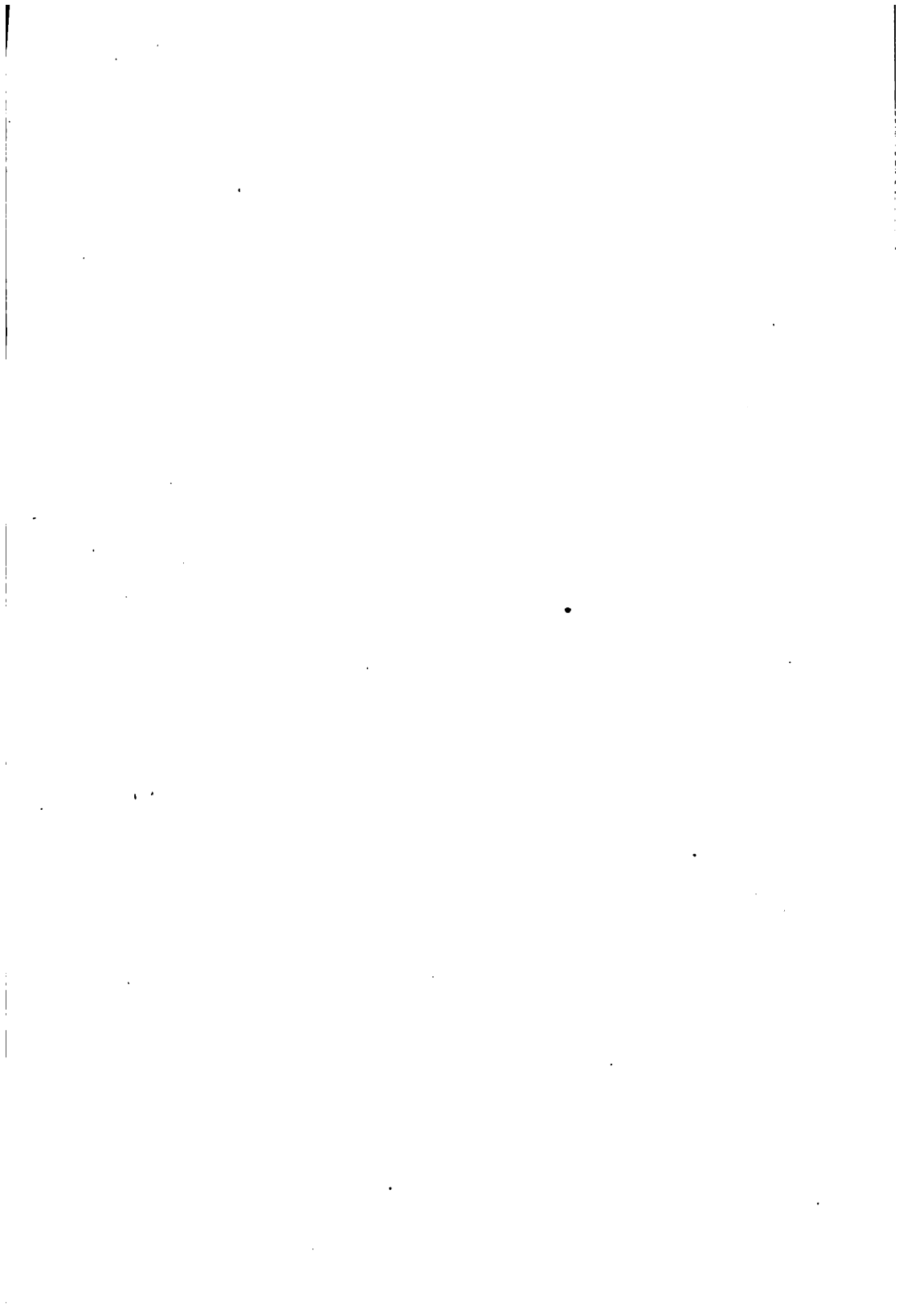

**AMERICAN SCHOOL FOR ORIENTAL STUDY AND RESEARCH  
IN PALESTINE.**

This School, founded by the Archæological Institute of America, opened in October 1900, its object being to offer advanced students from American institutions of learning opportunities of prosecuting investigations relating to history, both sacred and secular, topography, archæology, epigraphy, and kindred topics, and to explore and excavate historic sites. Applicants for admission must have a working knowledge of Latin, Greek, Hebrew, German, and French. The time of residence is from October 1st to June 1st. A student's necessary expenses are estimated at \$500, including travelling expenses from America.
