U-turn over cuts to NHS services

Health group drops planned changes to vulnerable adult and IVF treatments


CUTS to vital services have been abandoned by West Suffolk Clinical Commissioning Group after a public outcry.

WSCCG along with Ipswich and East Suffolk Clinical Commissioning Group (IESCCG) had been considering cuts to the IVF programme and services for marginalised and vulnerable adults (MVA).

The cuts would have saved £1 million from the groups' combined budg-

ets.
Members of the WSCCG governing body made the decision yesterday morn-

ing.
Almost 1,400 people responded to a public con-



sultation held by the two

Haverhill Mayor David Roach said: "I think it's really, really good news, especially for the vulnerable adults.

"The transport to Ipswich is difficult and it's ludicrous to get there.
"I think just positive

commonsense has prevailed.'

Had the cuts gone ahead, the Haverhill clinic for marginalised and vulnerable adults, such as refugees and homeless people, which is held every Wednesday would have been shut and patients would have had to

rely on poor travel links to Ipswich instead.

IVF services will continue as two cycles for women up to the age of 40 and one cycle for women up to the age of 42.

A decision was meant to be made in September but was deferred until January after public consultation. Dr Christopher Brown-

ing, chairman of WSCCG, said: "I am extremely pleased at how many people this engagement reached which highlights the commitment of West Suffolk CCG to talk with and listen to the views of our local population.

"While these decisions are ultimately good news, we must not underestimate the continued financial challenge facing the



Council tax rise approved

RESIDENTS are facing a 13 per cent rise in council tax.

At meetings on Tuesday night, both Haverhill Town Council and Suffolk County Council chose to increase their share of council tax.

For band B households, the most common in Haverhill, the rise is equivalent to 17p a week.

17p a week. Suffolk County Council has increased its precept by 3 per cent to fund adult social care.

Speaking at the full meeting of Haverhill Town Council, mayor David Roach said: "It's a difficult decision but if we want to keep our town with things our residents' love, all our local community groups, then these are the decisions we have to be mindful of."

In total the increase in the town council's precept will amount to £8.80 a year for band B households.

Town clerk Colin Poole said: "Whilst 10 per cent sounds a lot, it needs to be put into perspective. Our 10 per cent is less than one-third of the county council's 3 per cent increase."

Cllr Tony Brown said: "I'm extremely proud of what Haverhill Town Council does. Every penny gets spent on the town and the people of this town."

Cllr Maureen Byrne voiced concerns about the apparently significant increase.

Speaking at the meeting she said: "I think 10 per cent is quite a hike. There is still lots of poverty in this town, that £8.80 is two meals for some people."

Cllr Pat Hanlon was also unhappy about the rise but accepted that borough and county cuts to local services funding meant the town council was under more pressure to provide.

He pointed to the apprenticeship schemes run with One Haverhill and town

events like the fireworks as examples of town-funded projects.

He said: "We are doing what the borough and county council should be doing. For the town we should put it up but I don't like doing it."

Cllr Quillon Fox, who voted against the proposal, questioned why the rise was so much more than the 1.2

per cent increase last year.
The vote to raise Haverhill
Town Council's precept was
opposed by only two councillors. Cllr Paula Fox and
Cllr Quillon Fox both voted
against the increase.

POLICE

Month sees fall in crime figures

HAVERHILL Safer Neighbourhood Team has seen a decrease in crime.

November figures showed cases of anti-social behaviour more than halved from the previous month.

In October there were 82 incidents of anti-social behaviour compared to just 40 in November.

In the past month there have also been falls in the numbers of reported burglaries, serious sexual offences, violence causing injury and drug trafficking.

Since June 2016 there has generally been a downward trend in most crimes with spikes at certain times of the year.

In July there were 86 reported cases of antisocial behaviour.

Inspector Danny Cooper put these spikes down to the time of year, saying that school holidays tend to lead to higher incidents of anti-social behaviour.

October had the highest number of reports of serious sexual offences for the town at nine. There were five in November.

However, in June there was just one reported case of a serious sexual offence.

June and July also had the highest incidents of violence with an injury with 49 and 41 respectively.

Inspector Cooper said: "We will keep working to reduce these numbers."

Hero's medal is recognised

A FIRST World War soldier's forgotten heroism has been marked on his gravestone almost 100 years after his death.

Private William Bannister's war grave at Hildersham churchyard has now been altered to show that he had been awarded the Military Medal (MM), which was missed in the original inscription.

A mason from the Commonwealth War Graves Commission had to cut a new piece of stone into the memorial so that MM could be added after Pte Bannister's name.

Pte Bannister died of his wounds in the Eastern General Hospital, Cambridge, in December 1917, and was buried in Hildersham churchyard.

He had been awarded the medal for bravery in the field, although the full details of his heroism are not known.

Andrew Westwood-Bate, churchwarden and treasurer at Holy Trinity Church, Hildersham, said Pte Bannister, who was born at Barnardiston, had served in the 11th Battalion of the Suffolk Regiment, which was the Cambridge and Isle of Ely battalion, recruiting locally.

battalion, recruiting locally. He said: "The Suffolk Regiment was badly affected in the Battle of the Somme and in battles in 1917 and 1918.

"Willie survived the devastation of the first day of the Somme on the July 1, 1916, for the Battalion, ending up back in the trenches in October 1917.

"In an attack on October 21-22, the battalion lost a good deal of men. Willie was severely injured after displaying exemplary bravery," Mr Westwood-Bate said.

"Back in Cambridge, he was treated at the 1st Eastern General Hospital, where the University Library is today.

day.
"On December 4, 1917, he succumbed to his wounds and was laid to rest in Hildersham churchyard, as his father was a horse keeper in the village at the time."

He said that in January 1918 the King announced in the gazette that Pte Bannister had been awarded the Military Medal. This was recorded on the war memorial in the church, but not on the gravestone.

Mr Westwood-Bate said:

"It is the only war grave in the churchyard, and this year will be the 100th anniversary of his death."

He said the fact that Pte Bannister's gravestone was being corrected a century on was something to be welcomed

"Fascinatingly, as there is not enough room to add the information, a new bit of stone has been inserted," he added.

He said that although the insert was paler than the rest of the stone, it would blend in over the years.

Mr Westwood-Bate said Pte Bannister, the son of Walter and Emily Bannister, was shown in the census of 1911 as working as a teenage farm labourer in Impington.

He joined A Company of the 11th Battalion in 1914, together with many of his friends.

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission, which maintains war graves and also celebrates its centenary this year, said it did carry out alterations to gravestones from time to time when new information came in.

A spokesman for the Suf-

A spokesman for the Suffolk Regiment Museum in Bury St Edmunds said: "I am glad the MM is being added. I approve of that."



Devoted son is walking 566 miles in dad's boots

A LOYAL son is getting ready to trek 566 miles in memory of his late dad.

Liam Staples, 27, from Haverhill, is walking the Camino Frances trail, a walk his dad Mark had longed to join him on.

Liam will wear his dad's boots during his trek so his best friend can take every step with him, just

as they planned.

Liam said: "I'm taking his walking boots so he is doing every step with me.

"Me and my dad we were more like brothers, like Bonnie and Clyde, we did everything together. He was my best friend.

The duo had planned to set out for their second attempt at the walk in August last year, but Mark was diagnosed with terminal cancer a week before they were due to fly out.

The landscape designer said: "We planned to do it first in 2014 and then five miles into day three he got a hernia and we had



to fly home.

"So we decided to do it in 2016, he got himself all ship shape but then we got this devastating

Mark, 52, died just a week before Christmas, spurring Liam to finish the journey his dad would never get to take.

During the seven-week trek Liam will burn nearly 72,000 calories, the equivalent of two stone while taking nearly 2 million steps.

Liam will trek over the Pyrenees mountains, stopping off for only one or two days at a time in cities such as Pamplona and Santiago de Compostela, that his dad desperately wanted to see. The walk is 500 miles but Liam

is adding another 66 so he can walk to the sea where he will say a prayer engraved on a stone his dad got for their first trip in 2014.

Liam is aiming to raise £10,000 for St Nicholas Hospice in Bury St Edmunds where staff looked after his dad before he died. You can donate at https://www.justgiving.com/fundraising/oneemotionaljourney



New scheme to tackle poverty

REACH Community Projects, a charity which tackles poverty, has launched a programme of home visits in Haverhill.

The group usually runs debt advisory services and offers food parcels from its hub on the Clements Estate, but after piloting home visits in October, the group has rolled out the visits on a permanent basis.

Lesley Ashford-Smith, REACH's community outreach adviser, runs the home visits and believes that they will help the charity to help more people in need.

For those unable to leave their homes because of mental or physical reasons, home visits have these proved invaluable.

Mrs Ashford-Smith said: "People are just more comRACHAEL MCMENEMY @rach_mc94CN

fortable. One elderly lady had lots of debts and didn't know what to do. Her friends referred her to us.

"She was suffering with poor health and while at her home, I could see that just getting up from where she was sitting took a lot of ef-

fort.
"I could only do two home visits over many months and that was due to her cancelling because she kept falling ill. A home visit means the clients will have all the information at home which allows me to gather almost everything in one, two-hour visit.

"Now, her situation is un-der control and she is a lot

more at peace without the debt sitting over her.'

REACH hopes home visits can stop pride fettering people from asking for help. During the October pilot scheme the charity also started a weekly meeting in the Haverhill Job centre every Tuesday as part of a proactive poverty prevention scheme.

People can request a home visit after being re-ferred to REACH by social care or the job centre. They can also go to the Clements Estate hub and ask about a home visit.

RECORDED hate crime incidents towards disabled people in West Suffolk have risen by more than 700 per cent.

According to figures released after a Freedom of Information request, in 2015, there were six recorded incidents for the entire year – but in 2016, that figure rose to 49.

Other forms of recorded hate

Other forms of recorded hate crime in West Suffolk seem to be dropping.

dropping.
Vicky McDermott, chief executive
of Papworth Trust, which manages
the West Suffolk Disability Resource
Centre, told the News: "Disability
hate crime has no place in our communities and we must always do
everything we can to prevent disabled people becoming the target of
abuse.

"Sadly we know that this is an issue that is getting worse but importantly we are working with disabled people to enable them to be empowered to speak out when they are victims of hate crime.

"We would encourage any disa-

bled person who is subjected to hate crime abuse to report this to the police on 101 as quickly as possible."

The disability figures point towards incidents in places such as Haverhill, Newmarket, Mildenhall, Exning and Bury St Edmunds, among others.

among others.

However, other forms of recorded hate crime in West Suffolk are dropping.

Recorded racial hate crimes dropped from 117 incidents in 2015 to 99 in 2016

Religious hate crimes dropped from four to three.

Sexual orientation hate crimes in West Suffolk dropped from 21 to 14. Transgender hate crimes dropped from 2 to 1.

Matthew Hancock, MP for West Suffolk, said: "It is very good news that crime is falling in Suffolk, but the number of crimes against disabled people is a cause for concern. People with disabilities deserve our help, support and compassion. They are members of society like anyone

else and should be treated as such. Hate crimes against people with disabilities should not be tolerated and we must do everything we can to tackle abhorrent attitudes towards those with disabilities."

Chief Inspector Jo Garrard, from Suffolk Police, said: "The increase in the number of [disability] reports could be down to a growing awareness of the issue and an increase in the confidence of individuals to report such incidents to police.

"We know such crimes are under reported and we need all communities in Suffolk to know that abusive behaviour based on disability, sexuality, gender, race or religion is unacceptable and that it should be reported to police.

"Help and advice is available and all reports will be taken seriously and investigated. By reporting hate crime we have the best opportunity to stop it happening to someone else."

patients with hip fractures.
The latest ratings saw West Suffolk NHS Foundation Trust (WSFT) rise three places on last year to become best in the region and sixth

nationally. Samuel Samuel Parsons, orthopaedic consultant at WSFT, said: "Patient care is our priority and it is our team effort and organised approach that enables us to deliver this high quality service for the community.

"For our more elderly patients, hip surgery can really take its toll on their health. They are some-times very frail when they come to us, so it is paramount that we act quickly to enable them to regain mobility and a good quality of in-dependent life."

An integrated team has introduced regular virtual fracture clinics at West Suffolk Hospital so that patients' immediate care needs are identified and they see the right specialist at the earliest opportu-

The trust beat national averages across the board with 88.2 per cent of patients having surgery on or the day after admission compared to a national average of just 71.5 per cent. The average overall hospital stay was 17 days compared to a national average of 21.

St Edmundsbury Borough Council hopes the new playground will be open in time for the Easter holi-

days, weather permitting
Cllr Joanna Rayner, St Edmunds-bury Borough Council cabinet member for leisure and culture, said: "The play area at East Town Park is undergoing an exciting major transformation over these winter months that will see it dramatically increase in size to around four times as big as the old facility."

The council is spending £70,000 on the playground.

The play area has had no major refurbishment for 20 years with the exception of one new climbing

The updated playground will be packed with new equipment including a zip wire.

The work is being carried out as

The previous playground was closed and the equipment removed just before Christmas.

The council said this was to cause the least disruption since fewer children use the area during winter.

Parents and the group Friends of East Town Park were both consulted before a decision was made about

the proposed changes.

Cllr Rayner said: "We had eight designs submitted for the project, and the design by Wicksteed Leisure was chosen following consultation with The Friends of East Town Park, as well as a group of local parents all of whom had children of varying ages that use the park."

As part of improvements £30,000 will also be spent on new kiosk fa-cilities. The kiosk will have a visitors centre and sell snacks and drinks.

There's lots of ways to attract birds into the garden

NO DOUBT bird feeders and baths will be filled by many of us in the run-up to the annual Big Garden Birdwatch, the world's largest garden wildlife survey, which this year takes place from January 28-30.

Yet there are other ways to attract birds to your garden in the long term if you plant species which will provide them with both food and shelter.

Blackbirds and thrushes love the fruits and berries of plants including rowan, berberis and pyracantha, while ivy berries, which ripen later, are invaluable to hungry birds in late winter and early spring when food can he scarce

If you have room, consider planting an apple tree – birds love cooking, dessert apples and crab apples, whose windfalls can provide them with food in the leaner months. Early varieties of eating apples such as 'Beauty of Bath' and 'Discovery' don't keep well, so pick and eat what you need and leave the rest for your blackbirds, song and mistle thrushes, chaffinches, redwings and fieldfares.

Of course, you don't want the birds stripping your garden of all its colour, so consider planting some shrubs whose fruits they don't particularly like, including skimmia, aucuba and the guilder rose (Viburnum opu-

Hedging can also provide a great nesting site for birds, shelter during frosty nights and food. Bare root hedging is widely available from nurseries and garden centres from November to mid-April.

Holly is slow-growing, but is among the most effective hedges for birds. It ensures windproof shelter on frosty nights, nesting opportunities in spring and berries that attract blackbirds, thrushes and other birds. In spring, insects will be attracted to its flowers.

Plant wildlife-friendly vegetation, such as prickly

bushes and thick climbers in the garden to provide secure cover for birds. These should be close enough to where birds feed to provide cover, but not so close that cats can use it to stalk birds. This kind of planting may also provide food and nesting sites.

If you can bear to have an area of brambles in a quiet corner of the garden, birds should gravitate towards it. Blackbirds, thrushes, chaffinches, starlings, robins, pheasants, foxes, mice and other small mammals eat the fruits, while robins, wrens, thrushes, blackbirds, warblers and finches will nest in bramble and small mammals use it for protection

from predators

So, what are we likely to see during Big Garden Birdwatch?

Sightings of well-known species such as starlings and song thrushes experienced another drop during the event last year, although we spotted more than 8.5 million birds in total. The house sparrow remained top of the Big Garden Birdwatch rankings, with starling and blue tit rounding off the top three.



Cambridgeshire, including Linton.


A team of volunteers tackled their first project on Saturday by clearing up rubbish from a section of an old Roman road at Linton.

Running is not good for my health

HAVE mentioned before that my chosen form of exercise is running, Running is terrible. but I chose it because the other options were out of the question.

Swimming, for instance, is not for me. I am not massively keen on putting my face in the water because I have heard that water makes you drown and I cannot trust myself to breathe at the right time.

As a result. I swim at roughly a 45-degree angle, which means I do not glide through the water like a porpoise. Rather, I drag myself through the water, like a man crawling through the desert.

The gym, equally, is not for me. I tried it for a couple of weeks, when I was a much younger man, and found it like an adventure playground in which every piece of equipment is designed to hurt you.

So that leaves me with running. I do not run because I like it. I run because it is the only thing that might keep me from

dying before I qualify for a pension.

But the thing about running is that it is very boring. It is just putting one foot in front of the other over and over again until you stop - like life, only marginally faster.

Óbviously, this has an effect on you. On your run you notice very mundane things, and your brain tricks you into thinking they are

interesting just so that you do not die of boredom. "Oh, look," you think, "the branch on that tree is a bit like that other branch I passed eight minutes ago," or "Ooh, that jogger's got a white earphone cable like mine, I wonder what sort of phone she has?

It means your standards for what is interesting are lowered dramatically. This is why runners always tell you

how far they have run and post it on social media. They don't know how boring that stuff is. Runners are basically the vegans of the exercise world.

So I am going to tell you about my run the other day because I am not sure if this is interesting or not. I am going to count on your good manners either way.

I went for my run through the nearby park while it rained. I judged that it would keep my interest levels high. I might have seen a remarkable branch or some well turned-out railings.

But the problem with running through parks is that it increases your chances of encountering the natural predator of the runner: the small yappy dog.

It is not so much the fear of being bitten on the ankle although that is a factor - it is more the fear of

treading on the dog.

And small yappy dogs hunt in packs and are, it appears, invariably tethered to their owners by those retractable leads, which means that, as they run in front of you, they lay tripwires.

So, when on my run I approached a fork in the path, and on the right-hand path there was a cluster of small yappy dogs. I naturally took the left. next to a bubbling stream.

And there I met a Rottweiler, off its lead, its owner texting away and not massively attentive. I am naturally wary of Rottweilers, and before you write in and say, "Oh, I've got a Rottweiler, and he's never attacked anybody", remember that is like saying, "I have never been beaten in mortal combat".

The fact is, if I am attacked by a small yappy dog, it is an inconvenience and a tetanus jab. If I am attacked by a Rottweiler, I am toast, and I don't care how

friendly your Tyson is.

I continued running, remembering that showing fear was probably a bad idea, but the Rottweiler decided I was scared anyway, and made a beeline for my crotch.

I dodged, and ran off the path onto the bank by the stream. But the rain had made the bank muddy, and I skidded. Somehow, Ĭ managed to fling my right leg onto the path again, staying upright while turning my ankle and running while the Rottweiler switched its attention to my rear end.

But the residual mud on my trainer made me slip again and I fell hard against a tree.

The dog, tired of my antics, ran off to its still-texting and oblivious owner. I, on the other hand, limped home bruised. Running is terrible.

Lion could be a king at the Oscars

OME is where the heart is, but when memories of that place of sanctuary are cruelly stolen at an early age, can you truly be at peace?

One man's extraordinary true-life odyssey - to locate the birth mother and older brother he lost at the age of five – pro-vides the inspiration for Garth Davis' life-affirming drama, which looks set for recognition in multiple categories at next month's Academy Awards.

Screenwriter Luke Davies has skilfully adapted the non-fiction book A Long Way Home by Saroo Brierley, elegantly cutting back and forth between traumatic events more than 20 years apart to accompany the lead character on his seemingly hopeless quest for emotional closure.

Dev Patel and Sunny Pawar are both terrific as the 26-year-old and five-year-old incarnations of

LION (PG)

Saroo, who is unexpectedly transplanted from Khandwa, where family and friends speak Hindi, to the giddy whirl of Calcutta, where residents speak Bengali, and then onto Australia.

Cinematographer Greig Fraser captures these three locations on two continents in rich and meticulous detail, providing a compelling backdrop to the heart-wrenching trials and tribulations that will reduce audiences to puddles of saltwater emotion.

Saroo (Sunny Pawar) lives in 1987 Khandwa with his mother Kamla (Priyanka Bose) and siblings

The five-year-old idolises his 12-year-old brother Guddu (Abhishek Bharate) and the two boys embark on a night-time

excursion to the local railway

station. A horrible twist of fate separates the children and Saroo is trapped aboard a train, which heads 1.600km east to the bustling shanty towns of

Unable to speak the language, the boy eventually meets Saroi Sood (Deepti Naval), who runs the Indian Society for Sponsorship and Adoption and places him with adoptive parents John and Sue Brierley (David Wenham, Nicole Kidman) in Hobart, Tasmania.

Many years later, Saroo (now played by Patel) is enrolled on a course at the Royal Melbourne College of Hotel Management and casually confesses details of his past to other Indian students.

They encourage him to use online satellite mapping software to trace the railway line from Calcutta back west.

Fellow student Lucy (Rooney Mara) pledges her support to Saroo, whose studies suffer as he stares at pixels on his laptop screen, looking in vain for a station with a water tower that might be Khandwa.

Lion is a majestic, heartfelt drama that delivers an almighty emotional wallon as Saroo gradually pieces together his

Director Davis deftly moves between timeframes as he elicits riveting performances from Patel, Pawar and Kidman as a proud mother who will never stand in the way of her beautiful boy tracing his bloodline.

If a few stony-hearted souls remain steadfastly dry-eyed to the end, real-life footage over the credits and an explanation of the film's enigmatic title set to the soaring vocals of Australian chart-topper Sia, will prize open the floodgates.

ALSO SHOWING

MANCHESTER BY THE SEA (15)

LEE Chandler (Casey Affleck) works as a janitor in a small apartment building. It's an unedifying existence and Lee unfairly channels his resentment at the tenants. Out of the blue, Lee receives a

telephone call from family friend George (CJ Wilson) His older brother Joe (Kyle Chandler) has suffered a heart attack. By the time Lee arrives at the hospital, Joe has passed and the younger sibling must break the tragic news to his truculent



16-year-old nephew, Patrick (Lucas Hedges).
A meeting with the family lawyer reveals that Joe

named Lee as Patrick's legal guardian. But Lee is reluctant to be a parent again after the breakdown of his marriage. They both muddle through grief and misunderstanding as they make preparations for Joe's funeral.

Manchester By The Sea is anchored by Affleck's understated yet devastating portrayal, and the touching on-screen chemistry with co-star Hedges.

LA LA LAND (12A)

ASPIRING actress Mia (Emma Stone) works as a barista in between auditions, which repeatedly end in crushing rejection. On a traffic-jammed Los Angeles freeway, she crosses paths with talented pianist Sebastian (Ryan Gosling), who reveres jazz in its purest form, but is forced to play saccharine standards by restaurant owner Bill (JK Simmons).

Sebastian is convinced he can spearhead a new appreciation for music until an old classmate, Keith (John Legend), questions his devotion to masters of a bygone era. Frustrations between the couple come to a head in a fractious to and fro about artistic integrity.

La La Land is a perfect marriage of directorial brio, tour-de-force performance and jaw-dropping production design. Gosling and Stone are individually luminous and electrifying as a double-act in high energy song and dance sequences.

A MONSTER CALLS (12A)

RECLUSIVE schoolboy Conor O'Malley (Lewis MacDougall) is in denial about the dark shadow hanging over his mother Lizzie (Felicity Jones). He soaks up physical abuse at school from a bully and seeks refuge each night in his

vivid illustrations.
As darkness falls and midnight strikes, the yew tree which stands guard over the nearby church magically comes to life and morphs into a gnarled creature (voiced by Liam Neeson).

is MacDougall

The behemoth visits Conor and promises to share three parables. The creature demands just one thing from Conor in return: "Tell me your nightmare." Each night, the creature spins his yarn and the boy listens intently, searching for meaning in the words. But he only finds bitterness and confusion.

JACKIE (15)

TOWARDS the conclusion of Chilean director Pablo Larrain's unconventional biopic of Jacqueline Kennedy, the former first First Lady muses on the celebrity that consumed her.

"I never wanted fame," she responds coolly. "I just became a Kennedy."

That feeling of impotence in the eye of a media storm informs many pivotal scenes

in Jackie, a bravura portrait of a wife and mother struggling to come to terms with sudden loss whilst publicly remaining strong for her children and the

American people. Screenwriter Noah Oppenheim sensitively imagines grief behind closed doors to piece

together events before and after the fateful motorcade in Dallas, Texas on November 22, 1963. Scenes of Jackie (Natalie Portman) trembling with shock as she wipes

make-up and her husband's blood from her face in the aftermath of the shooting are horribly compelling, as is the moment she must break the devastating news to her two children.

Larrain's film is a mesmerising kaleidoscope of real and imagined details, galvanized

by Portman's haunting embodiment of a widow in

emotional isolation. 'It's been just one week and already they're treating him like some dusty old artefact, to be shelved away," despairs Jackie, fearing the memory of her husband will be lost in time like so many of his predecessors.

The colourful and complex mosaic of Larrain's vision ensures that the woman, who stood proudly beside JFK, won't be forgotten.

What are hydrogen cars and how do they work?

OME alternatively-fuelled power options are well-known now. Electric cars, for instance, are gaining popularity and are becoming a common sight on UK roads, especially within cities.

Hydrogen-powered cars, however, are a slightly rarer sight. The technology they use is in its relative infancy, which means not a lot is known about how they work and the benefits they bring. We're going to

First of all, just how do hydrogen cars work? Well, in fuel cell cars, power is generated by reacting hydrogen with oxygen. The energy that comes from this reaction is then stored in the car's batteries. The electricity stored here then runs the electric motors which then power the wheels. It's better to think of a hydrogen car as an electric vehicle that is able to charge itself up. At higher speeds, the car can use its supply of hydrogen to directly power the motor, instead of recharging the car's onboard batteries

The benefit of this? Hydrogen isn't used as an existing energy source, like

fossil fuels. Because hydrogen is in such abundance in our atmosphere, there's a plentiful supply, too.

The best part? The only thing it emits is water. It also takes a matter of minutes to refill a hydrogen car, compared to several hours to charge one powered by electricity alone.

However, there are a few drawbacks. Hydrogen, though plentiful in our atmosphere, is incredibly difficult to produce. Although there's lots of it about, it's most frequently found in compounds such as water – which makes it difficult to separate. Because of the huge amount of energy needed to

isolate the hydrogen, fossil fuels are required – which goes against the efficiency of the car.

Environmentally-friendly ways of producing hydrogen do exist, but they're expensive and can't create it in great enough quantities to be useful. So the only easy way of producing hydrogen is with fossil

There are other drawbacks, too. Currently, there are only two hydrogen cars on sale in the UK today the Hyundai ix35 and the Toyota Mirai. Choice of cars, therefore, is somewhat limited. Also, because hydrogen needs to be contained

securely and at high pressure, these cars need to carry large tanks, which take up quite a lot of space inside the

... You'll also have to ensure you're within range of a hydrogen filling station. Currently, there are just eight filling stations in the UK - with three located in the London area alone. Though more are planned, for now it means you'll have to be conscious of how far you need to travel to fill up.

Lastly, and guite importantly, the cars are quite expensive. The Mirai costs from £53,105, while the Mirai commands more of a premium at £63,100. Filling them up will cost around £65, and you'll get similar fuel

economy figures to a regular diesel car. For now, hydrogen cars are slightly hampered by a lack of infrastructure and the cost of creating their fuel in the first place. However, with more research and a lowering of price, hydrogen cars may yet turn out to be the smart choice for those looking to get around in the most economical fashion possible.

The Crossland X will be up against rivals such as the Renault Captur and Peugeot 2008 and Vauxhall says the newcomer, which goes on sale in summer, has a firm family focus offering "Tardis-like" cabin space providing a high degree of practicality and flexibility. At just 4.21 metres in length the

Crossland X is more compact than

than the Astra hatchback, which will offer easier driving and manoeuvring in towns and cities.

It also has the advantage of an elevated seating position and an overall height, which is raised ten centimetres above the Astra's.

Another useful feature of the new SUV is the ability to slide the rear seats back or forwards to allow more space for legroom or boot space which can offer a class-leading 410 litres with the rear seats up. When the rear seats are folded down completely, luggage capacity increases

The Crossland X will come with a goodly set of gear to make driving safer and more comfortable, and include a 180-degree panoramic rear-view camera, advanced park assist, forward collision alert with pedestrian detection and autonomous emergency braking, lane departure warning, speed sign recognition and side blind-spot alert, among others

Drivers will also benefit from modern connectivity that is becoming the norm in Vauxhall models. The Vauxhall OnStar connectivity system,

equipment which is compatible with Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, keeps drivers connected through an up to eight-inch colour touchscreen.

As far as engines go, Vauxhall has not given details of what will be under the bonnet of the Crossland X but says that an extensive petrol/diesel engine line up with manual and automatic transmissions will be offered.

No prices have been announced for the newcomer to the Vauxhall stable but the entry level Crossland X is likely to come in at around the £15,000 mark.
