ACT 1

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE SENATE IN THE SPECIAL SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF HAWAII OF THE YEAR 1904, FROM THE PUBLIC TREASURY.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. There shall be and hereby is appropriated the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the Public Treasury for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Senate in the Special Session of the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from and after the date of its approval.

ACT 2

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF HAWAII IN THE SPECIAL A. D. 1904 SESSION FROM THE PUBLIC TREASURY.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. There shall be and hereby is appropriated the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from the Public Treasury of the Territory of Hawaii for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii in its special A. D. 1904 session.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from and after the date of its approval.

ACT 3

AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 13 OF THE EXTRA SESSION OF 1903 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE CALLED SECTION 6A.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Act 13 of the Session Laws of 1903 is hereby amended by adding a new section after Section 6, as follows:

"Section 6a. No payments shall be made under any of the appropriations under this Act for any bills incurred after June 30th, 1904."

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

ACT 4

AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 17 OF THE EXTRA SESSION OF 1903 BY
ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE CALLED SECTION 5A.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Act 17 of the Extra Session Laws of 1903 is hereby amended by adding a new section after Section 5, as follows:

“Section 5a. No payments shall be made under any appropriations of this Act for any services performed after June 30th, 1904.”

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

ACT 5

AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 51 OF THE LAWS OF 1896, ENTITLED “AN
ACT RELATING TO INTERNAL TAXES AND TO REPEAL CHAPTER
61 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1892 RELATIVE THERETO” BY
AMENDING SECTION 45 THEREOF.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 45 of Chapter 51 of the Session Laws of

1896 (Civil Laws, 1897, Section 848), is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 45. Each Assessor shall receive such compensation as the Legislature from time to time appropriates. Each Deputy shall receive as full compensation for assessing and collecting and all work done in connection therewith, such percentage of the taxes collected by him, including road and school taxes, not to exceed five (5) per-centum, or such salary not to exceed five (5) per-centum, as the Assessor, with the approval of the Treasurer may decide: *Provided, however,* that the commissions so paid shall be a charge upon each tax separately.”

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from and after the date of its approval.

ACT 6

AN ACT RELATING TO CLEANING OF STREETS, REMOVAL OF GARBAGE, DEAD ANIMALS, AND OTHER NUISANCES, CLEANING OF CESSPOOLS, AND MAKING SEWER CONNECTIONS IN THE CITY OF HONOLULU, AND TO ESTABLISH RATES AND CHARGES IN SUCH MATTERS.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Public Works, conforming to the requirements of the Board of Health, to direct and superintend the cleaning of the public streets and by-ways of the city of Honolulu; the removal and disposal of garbage, dead animals and other nuisances therein; the cleaning of cesspools and connecting of premises with the public sewer in said city.

SECTION 2. The rates of charges for such services and for use of the sewer shall be fixed from time to time by the Superintendent, subject to the approval of the Governor, and shall be reasonably approximate to the cost of work done and material used.

Rates of charges for sewer use shall be fixed as nearly as reasonably may be, so that the entire yearly receipts for sewer use shall not exceed the total yearly cost of maintaining and repairing the sewers, together with the yearly interest on the bonds representing the cost of the sewer system.

SECTION 3. The rates and charges herein provided, for the collection of garbage, shall be payable to the Superintendent quarterly, in advance, and the charge for sewerage semi-annually, in advance. Charges for cesspools, sewer connections and removal of animals and other nuisances, shall be payable on demand; and to secure such payment, the Superintendent of Public Works may require a deposit in advance.

SECTION 4. If a sewer rate shall remain unpaid for fifteen days after it is due, ten per cent. in addition to the regular rate shall be charged, and every such sewer rate or charges shall be a lien upon the property connected with said sewer, which said lien shall attach to said property as of the date when said sewer rate or charge is due and payable to said Superintendent of Public Works, as hereinabove provided.

The rates and charges shall be payable by the owners and occupants of the premises in respect to which the services are rendered, and who shall jointly and severally be liable therefor.

SECTION 5. Any District Magistrate of Honolulu shall have jurisdiction to hear and determine all civil actions, suits or proceedings brought by the Superintendent of Public Works for the collection and enforcement of collection and payment of all sewer rates or charges which may be assessed, as above set forth, notwithstanding the amount claimed.

SECTION 6. The record books of the Superintendent of Pub-

lic Works, in the matters herein above specified, shall be *prima facie* proof of the amount of sewerage rates or charges due and unpaid to said Superintendent.

SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect from the date of its approval.

ACT 7

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13, ACT 56 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1903.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 13 of Act 56 of the Session Laws of 1903 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 13. The Judge and Registrar of the Court of Land Registration shall receive such salaries as shall be appropriated by the Legislature. In the absence of such provision all salaries of officers or employees or fees of examiners of title shall be paid out of the appropriation for expenses Court of Land Registration, according to a schedule fixed by the Governor. All fees or costs received by any assistant registrars with an application shall be transmitted with such application to the Registrar.”

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from and after the first day of July, A. D. 1904.

ACT 8

AN ACT RELATING TO MALICIOUS INJURIES, AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ACT 35 OF THE LAWS OF 1896 (PENAL LAWS, SECTION 200).

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 35 of the Laws of 1896 (Penal Laws, Section 200,) is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 1. Whoever negligently or maliciously destroys, or injures any real or personal property of another, or injures or disturbs another in any of his rights or privileges of person or property shall be deemed guilty of malicious injury and shall be punished by imprisonment at hard labor not more than one year, or by fine not exceeding one thousand dollars.”

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on the twentieth day after its approval.

ACT 9

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF ACT 42 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1903.

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of Act 42 of the Session Laws of 1903 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“The Treasurer of the Territory may, with the approval of the Governor, determine the denomination of such bonds to be issued under the authority of this Act, and the place in which.

the principal and interest of such bonds, or any of them, shall be payable, and the method of their redemption. He may make such arrangements as may be necessary or proper for the sale of the whole or any part of the authorized issue. Such arrangements shall provide for the sale of such bonds by the Government itself, by public advertisement for tenders, but no bonds shall be issued at less than two per cent. below their nominal par value; or the Treasurer may, with the approval of the Governor, accept any bid without public advertisement for tenders, provided such bid shall be above the figure of the last sale."

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from the date of its approval.

ACT 10

AN ACT TO REPEAL ACT 79 OF THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FACILITIES OF THE HAWAIIAN TREASURY AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS BETWEEN THE FIRST DAY OF JUNE AND THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER IN EACH YEAR."

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. That Act 79 of the Provisional Government is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect from the date of its approval.

ACT II

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF ACT 49 OF THE SESSION LAWS OF 1898, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO FURTHER PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT ACCOUNTS".

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 49 of the Session Laws of 1898 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. The Treasurer, with the approval of the Governor, is authorized during each biennial period to open a bank account, or bank accounts, in the name of the Government of the Territory of Hawaii, with any bank or banks or financial institutions carrying on business in Honolulu, and, from time to time during each such period, to receive on loan, by way of over-draft on such account or accounts, such sums of money not to exceed in the aggregate \$500,000.00 at any one time, as the said Treasurer and the said Governor may deem necessary to meet the current expenses of the said Government."

SECTION 2. Section 3 of said Act is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. No money shall be obtained on such account or accounts except by draft of the Treasurer, countersigned by the Auditor and approved by the Governor."

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon date of its approval.

ACT 12**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SALARIES AND PAY OF EMPLOYEES OF THE TERRITORY.**

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. The following sums amounting to Nine Hundred and Sixty-three Thousand, Four Hundred and Four Dollars (\$963,404.00) are hereby appropriated to be paid out of all moneys in the Treasury of the Territory, received from all current receipts of the general revenue, for the payment of Salaries of Officers and the pay of employees for the period commencing with the first day of July, 1904, and ending with the thirtieth day of June, 1905:

SECTION 2. The Auditor shall not draw a warrant in payment for any of the objects named in this Act, except as herein provided, and the unauthorized expenditure of any money from the Treasury to be thereafter accounted for to the Legislature by indemnity bill, is hereby expressly prohibited.

SECTION 3. No officer or other employee of the Government holding more than one office shall be authorized to draw more

than the salary of the highest grade of the office held by him, and he shall be entitled to no further compensation.

SECTION 4. It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to continue to make payments in accordance with appropriations authorized by this Act, until the thirtieth day of June, 1905; provided that the Auditor shall not draw a warrant for any sum on account of any bill for salaries and pay rolls in this Act in excess of the due proportions of the amount appropriated for such item for the time elapsed.

SECTION 5. All sums appropriated by Act 16 of the Extra Session of 1903, other than those for items for which appropriations were made under Act 17 of said Extra Session, are hereby re-appropriated for the period commencing with the First day of January, 1904, and ending with the Thirtieth Day of June, 1904, and all warrants issued and payments made under said Act 16 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on the first day of July, 1904, except Section 5 thereof, which shall take effect on the date of its approval.

Any public official who shall falsely certify or approve for payment any bill or voucher against any item of this Act, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, for which the offender shall, on conviction thereof, be fined not less than Fifty Dollars nor more than Five Hundred Dollars. (District Magistrates shall have jurisdiction in all cases under this section.)

SECTION 4. No expenditure of public money for the construction or repair of public works (except street or road work) where the sum to be expended shall amount to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or more, or for the purchase of material, provisions or other supplies for public purposes amounting in the aggregate to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or more, shall be made, except by contract after public advertisement for sealed tenders; and no public work or the purchase of material, provisions or supplies for public purposes shall be so divided or parcelled out as to defeat or evade the provisions of this section.

SECTION 5. All agreements or contracts made and entered into by any officer of the Territory of Hawaii by or under which public money is to be expended, shall be void and of no effect unless the Auditor shall endorse thereon his certificate that there remains, unexpended and unapplied, a balance in the fund or appropriation already made for such purpose, sufficient to cover the amount involved in such contract or agreement.

SECTION 6. All sums appropriated by Act 10 of the Extra Session of 1903, other than those for items for which appropriations were made under Act 13 of said Extra Session, are hereby re-appropriated for the period commencing with the first day of January, 1904, and ending with the thirtieth day of June, 1904; and all warrants issued and payments made under said Act 10 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on the first day of July, 1904, *except* Section 6 thereof, which shall take effect on the date of its approval.
